

Minutes Historic Sign Review Committee June 11, 2010

Blada called the meeting to order at 8:33 am.

<u>1405 Mt. Rushmore Road – Freedom Tattoo – Ground Sign</u>

Geiger moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the ground sign for Freedom Tattoo at 1405 Mt. Rushmore Road. M. Selbach discussed the sign and sign colors. Jackson and Blada indicated that the bright yellow and orange colors of the sign are not aesthetically appealing for either the contributing historic structure or the West Boulevard Historic District. Blada stated that the building is gray and the color of the current sign on the building is black and white. Geiger concurred that the sign should complement the building. Kingsbury indicated that black and white or neutral colors would be more appropriate for the sign. M. Selbach agreed to providing the sign with either black and white colors or a neutral color to complement the building and current signage. Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded and passed unanimously to approve a substitute motion to approve the ground sign for Freedom Tattoo at 1405 Mt. Rushmore Road with the sign colors to be black and white or a neutral color.
