615 Main Street – Mona Lisa’s – Pedestrian Sign

**Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the pedestrian sign for Mona Lisa’s at 615 Main Street.** In response to a question by Kingsbury, Heil explained the location of the sign between the lights over the doorway. In response to a question by Jackson, Heil explained that the sign would be located above the ledge and the integrity of the ledge would remain. **The motion to approve the pedestrian sign for Mona Lisa’s at 615 Main Street was approved unanimously.**

609 St. Joseph Street – Bella of the Black Hills – Change Sign Colors on existing Wall and Pedestrian Sign

**Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the change in colors for the existing wall and pedestrian sign for Bella of the Black Hills at 609 St. Joseph Street.** In response to a question by Kingsbury, Wieseler indicated that the pedestrian sign will be double faced and replaced on the same brackets. Wieseler further stated that the wall sign is dimensional with raised letters. Jackson indicated his support for the colors. **The motion to approve the change in colors for the existing wall and pedestrian sign for Bella of the Black Hills at 609 St. Joseph Street passed unanimously.**

Bulman reported on the status of the sign application for 321 7<sup>th</sup> Street.

Jackson reported on potential sign code changes that the Ad hoc Committee is reviewing. Jackson indicated that the Ad Hoc Committee is considering allowing a permit to be issued for banners and inflatable signs to be used on a short term basis.
