529 Main Street (508 6<sup>th</sup> Street) – Karma Boutique – Window Sign

**Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the window sign for Karma Boutique at 529 Main Street.** In response to a question by Geiger, Sievers described the window location and that the sign will be located on the inside of the window. In response to a question from Kingsbury regarding the pink color, Sievers indicated that the business colors are pink and gold and she requested the window sign remain pink. **The motion to approve the window sign for Karma Boutique at 529 Main Street passed unanimously.**

506 6<sup>th</sup> Street – Gunderson Palmer Law Firm – Relocate Wall Signs to Window Signs

**Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the relocation of two wall signs to window signs for Gunderson Palmer Law Firm at 506 6<sup>th</sup> Street.** Bulman explained that the relocation of the signs is needed to meet Historic grant stipulations. Bulman further indicated that the bronze signs, previously approved to be located on the pillars, will be removed and two of the signs will now be aluminum and will be located on the inside of the windows using stainless steel brushed silver cables. **The motion to approve the relocation of two wall signs to window signs for Gunderson Palmer Law Firm at 506 6<sup>th</sup> Street, passed unanimously.**
