

Minutes Historic Sign Review Committee November 29, 2011

Blada called the meeting to order at 8:35 am.

Kingsbury moved and Jackson seconded to approve the 3 pedestrian signs and one wall sign for Bob Fuchs of Fatter Boys, LLC at 616 Main Street. Fuchs explained that the three pedestrian signs will include the Firehouse Mercantile, Beautiful Contouring, and Bernard Marketing. Fuchs further explained that the wall sign will be for the Firehouse Mercantile and replaces the current Roam'n Around sign. In response to a question by Blada, Fuchs stated that the signs will be wood materials and not illuminated. In response to a question by Kingsbury, Fuchs described the colors of the signs. Jackson indicated that Rosenbaum Signs has the contract for the signs and as such, he will be abstaining from the vote. Jackson further stated that he will request that the signs be placed in the mortars of the building and not the bricks. In response to a question by Kingsbury, Fuchs indicated that the brackets are currently in place for the Roam'n Around sign and the signs will be located on the columns of the building. The motion to approve the 3 pedestrian signs and one wall sign for Bob Fuchs of Fatter Boys, LLC at 616 Main Street passed, with Jackson abstaining.
