523 6th Street – Conrad Signs for Alex Johnson Hotel – Neon Pedestrian Sign

Jackson moved and Geiger seconded to approve the neon pedestrian sign for the Alex Johnson Hotel at 523 6th Street. In response to a question by Kingsbury, Fenhaus explained the dimensions of the pedestrian sign and the sign location. In response to a question by Jackson, Fenhous explained that the sign will be fastened to an existing bracket from a previous sign. Geiger indicated that the color of the sign will not be complimentary to the awning and current sign of Seattle's Best Coffee. Fenhaus indicated that the color is requested by the client as it is similar to the logo colors of the business. Discussion followed. In response to a question by Kingsbury, Fenhaus indicated that Seattle's Best Coffee was notified and they have approved the neon sign for the Alex Johnson Hotel.
