

**Minutes
Historic Sign Review Committee
October 3, 2014**

Blada called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

201 Main Street (14SN026)

Hanzel presented the request and reviewed the drawings and photographs

Jackson moved to open discussion on the sign permit. The motion was seconded by Kingsbury and carried unanimously.

In response to a question from Blada, Faltynski advised that the vinyl sign will be placed in the window on the front of the building and that the metal sign will be placed on the metal that is currently located above the window on the east side of the building

Kingsbury moved to approve the 4' x 5' 8" metal sign and the 1' 10.75" x 2' 11" vinyl sign at 201 Main Street. The motion was seconded by Jackson and carried unanimously.

629 Main Street (14SN027)

Hanzel presented the request and reviewed the drawings.

Brinkman informed the Committee that the business owner prefers option #1 but has provided a second option for the Committee to review.

Kingsbury moved to open discussion on the sign permit. The motion was seconded by Jackson and carried unanimously.

Jackson advised that he works for Rosenbaum's Signs. He added that he could support the location of the sign within the band as identified in option #2 because it will help preserve the historical integrity of the building and would provide continuity in the downtown area.

Kingsbury moved to approve the 2' x 8' wall sign and the 32" x 23"/29" x 10" hanging sign at 629 Main Street. The motion was seconded by Jackson and carried with Kingsbury and Blada voting yes and Jackson abstaining.
