Due to complaints, the City of Rapid City recently completed an inspection of the property listed above and neighboring properties. That inspection revealed that stove and items are stored on your property. These are considered nuisances and are in violation of the Rapid City Municipal Code. The City requires that these nuisances to be stored within an enclosed structure or removed from the property.

1. The Rapid City Municipal Code states in § 8.16.010 that rubbish, building materials, lumber, vehicle parts, appliances, yard waste, yard equipment, noxious matter, and other debris not normally associated with residential areas are considered nuisances and must be stored in an enclosed structure or removed from the property.

The property owner and/or resident, have until 8:00 a.m., March 27, 2000 to be in compliance.

Appeals to this order must be made to the Office of the Building Official, in writing, and within fifteen days of the issuance of the order, at 300 6th Street, Rapid City, SD 57701. Failure to appeal will result in the waiver of all rights to an administrative hearing.
