## **ORDINANCE NO. 3689**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15.13.015 AND 15.13.020 OF THE RESIDENTIAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE ORDINANCE AS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE IN CHAPTER 15.13 OF THE RAPID CITY MUNICIPAL CODE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City of Rapid City that paragraph J of Section 15.13.015, of the Rapid City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 15.13.015 License application.

J. Continuing Education. The requirement for triennial renewal is one hour of attendance, <u>for every year the license is in effect</u>, at a code class approved by the building inspection office. The class topics shall include, but are not limited to (1) legal requirements of the code; (2) local amendments to the code; (3) requirements for group R occupancies; and (4) requirements for group U occupancies.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City of Rapid City that Section 15.13.020 of the Rapid City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 15.13.020 License application fees.

Published: Effective:

- A. Each person applying for a residential contractor's license shall pay to the city finance officer an initial fee of seventy five dollars two hundred dollars. The license is valid for three years. The triennial renewal fee shall be one hundred dollars. The code book, Dwelling Construction Under the Uniform Building Code, shall be included with the fee.
- B. A person may put his residential contractor's license under inactive status; however, during that time, he may not work as a residential building contractor within the city.

CITY OF RAPID CITY

1. The license application fee <u>and continuing education requirement</u> for inactive status shall be the same as active status, <u>seventy five dollars two hundred dollars initial fee and one hundred dollars renewal fee</u> every three years, <u>and one hour of continuing education every year</u>.
