RE:

Moratorium and Travel

The Common council placed travel except for \$3,000 into moratorium. We are placing a request to have \$4,000 additional funding placed into our travel line item to cover expenses for the first several months of the year. Some of these are estimates at this time because of incomplete information. The normal travel requests will be submitted for all travel.

Here is a list of most of the travel expenses that we propose to incur for the first part of 2004.

These are wildland classes that we either require or are needed in case of large wildfires \$300 S-classes especially in our large urban interface environment. They are from \$25 to \$100 for

registration. To date these are local classes and will not require other expenses for travel.

Fire Department Instructors Conference. This is a national class for instructors to learn **FDIC** \$3,000

techniques, what is coming to the fire service, and a chance to see what equipment is available to make the job safer for everyone. We try and send someone from the education division and one other person that instructs in the department. There are 3 days of instruction sessions and up to 2 days of displays. If we pay the registration prior to the

middle of February we save approximately \$200

There are a variety of wildland classes and other officer learning opportunities. We Midwinter Muster \$150

generally send 5-10 people at \$15 apiece.

This is held in Brooking this year and we do not have a class schedule yet. Depending on State Fire School \$800

the program we could send from 2-6 people. This is held in June.

This is for the secretary to help handle the increasing load since we have taken Handling the Front Desk \$199

on the EMS duties and hired more employees.

South Dakota Instructors Conference. This is a class to maintain certification with the **SDIC** \$300

> state. We have 6-8 certified instructors. It is required to attend a training session every two years and we try and split the time among the instructors. This is held the second

weekend in January.

International Congress of Building Officials. The Fire Prevention division tries to send **ICBO** \$1400

two people a year to this to keep up on code issues. With the push by more builders to change codes it is imperative that we are up to date on what the codes are and how they

apply to building in our city.
