Dear Artists In Schools & Communities Sponsor:

We are pleased to announce that details of your application for an Artists In Schools & Communities (AISC) residency have received final approval. Sponsors of AISC residencies will receive a matching grant from the South Dakota Arts Council (SDAC) for one-half of the artist's fee plus travel.

SDAC funding provided at \$800.00 plus travel at \$107.88, for a matching grant of \$907.88 awarded to City of Rapid City (Recreation Department).

On the last day of the residency, <u>City of Rapid City (Recreation Department)</u> is responsible for paying <u>Childrens Theatre Co of South Dakota \$1,707.88</u>, which includes the Arts Council's grant of \$907.88 plus the sponsor match of \$800.00.

PROGRAM CREDIT: The local sponsor agrees to print on all published materials and in all public announcements the following credit line: South Dakota Arts Council support is provided with funds from the State of South Dakota, through the Department of Tourism and State Development, and the National Endowment for the Arts.

<u>EVALUATION:</u> An evaluation form must be completed and sent to SDAC within 30 days after the conclusion of the residency.

<u>TERMINATION:</u> If for unforeseen circumstances, the above described residency does not take place, the sponsor will return the entire grant award to SDAC.

In order to secure payment of your Grant Award:

- (1) ✓ Fill in the name of the county and the taxpayer identification number (TIN) at the top of the first page of this Artists In Schools & Communities Grant Award letter. ✓ Read and agree to comply with the AISC residency requirements outlined on the bottom of page 2. ✓ Sign and date the letter on the bottom of page 2 and return the original to the South Dakota Arts Council. Keep the COPY for your records.
- (2) Enter into a contract with the artist by signing the enclosed Artists-In-Schools AGREEMENT BETWEEN ARTIST AND SPONSOR. This document outlines the specific agreement between the artist and the sponsor concerning the terms and conditions of the residency. Sign, date and return all three copies (white, yellow and pink) to SDAC. One copy will be returned to you after the artist's signature has been secured.
- (3) <u>Complete and return the W-9 form</u>. The information on this form should be for the sponsoring organization, NOT the artist.
- (4) Read and sign the accompanying **Grant Terms and Conditions/Certified Assurances** document. <u>Return this signed document to SDAC</u>. Keep the COPY for your records.

You will NOT receive payment of your grant award unless the above-mentioned documents are
on file at the South Dakota Arts Council.

As the Sponsor's authorized representative, I have read the residency requirements outlined on pages 5-15 of the *Residency Planning Manual* and agree to the following provisions governing the Artists In Schools & Communities Program.

- ⇒ The artist will be scheduled for no more than 4 sessions (40-60 minutes each session) per day, unless an alternative schedule is negotiated with the artist (e.g. 5 sessions one day and 3 the next).
- ⇒ Some sessions will be scheduled with **core groups** of participants over an extended period of days, allowing for an indepth experience, rather than simply exposure to the art form.
- The artist will not be viewed as a member of the teaching staff, but as a professional resource person, providing enrichment to the curriculum. The classroom teacher or sponsor representative will be actively present in the classroom and participate in activities whenever appropriate. This person is responsible for classroom discipline.
- The sponsor will provide lodging for the artist during the residency. The artist may be housed in a private home, dormitory, hotel/motel or similar facility, providing there is no cost to the artist.
- ⇒ The sponsor is responsible for expendable participant supplies utilized during the residency. During the planning for the residency, artist and sponsor should agree on necessary supplies and costs.

I further agree to all other provisions outlined in this <u>ARTISTS IN SCHOOLS & COMMUNITIES GRANT AWARD</u>, the accompanying <u>GRANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS</u> & <u>CERTIFIED ASSURANCES</u> statements, and the RESIDENCY PLANNING MANUAL.
