The United Downtown Association wishes to request metered parking spaces for 11 days during the Sturgis Motorcycle Rally for Aug 4-14, 2005. We feel that this gesture would show the rally goers a willingness, by Rapid City, to make a more "biker friendly" environment which would be conducive to doing business and spending leisure time in the downtown area. Additionally, we feel that choosing this parking arraignment would cause the least impact on those downtown merchants whose businesses derive little from the rally.
