

ORDINANCE NO. 5191

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A DEFINITION OF “TEENAGE CARE CENTER” BY
AMENDING CHAPTER 17.04 OF THE RAPID CITY MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, Rapid City has adopted zoning regulations identifying uses permitted in all zoning districts pursuant to the authority granted to it by Chapter 11-4 of the South Dakota Codified Laws; and

WHEREAS, Teenage Care Centers will serve an important function and should be allowed as a Conditional Use Permit within an appropriate zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the definition of “Teenage Care Center” is not currently identified under the City’s zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rapid City deems it to be in the City’s best interest to define “Teenage Care Center” within the City’s zoning ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Rapid City, that Section 17.04.677 be added to the Rapid City Municipal Code to read as follows:

17.04.677 Teenage Care Center.

“Teenage Care Center” means a facility, by whatever name, in which supervision, tutoring, counseling, education, transportation and recreation is provided on a regular basis with compensation for four or more children between 10 and 19 years of age and their families. Meals may be provided; however, no overnight accommodations may be allowed. Administrative offices associated with the program may also be allowed.
