The main focus is on ground fuels reduction in order to make houses and subdivisions defensible in wildfire and less prone to disease. Most of this will be for ground fuels mitigation in ponderosa pine and related species. We are working with private landowners to develop defensible space around homes and subdivisions in the case of wildfire; We are also working with South Dakota Department of Agriculture - Wildland Fire Suppression Division to develop a Community Wildfire Protection Plan. This will be used to evaluate fuels and areas that are at high risk within the large area of wildland urban interface that we have in Rapid City.

	promote the projects and the need for mitigation.
