Subject: Reallocation of 2007 Parks and Recreation CIP

Funds

Attached please find the revised Parks & Recreation Five Year Plan (2007) which was approved by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board on February 1, 2007. Funding for Braeburn Dog Park Improvements was increased by \$50,000 and funding for the Canyon Lake Park Lighting Master Plan was identified as \$30,000. The lighting replacement portion of this project will be done in 2008 once the master plan is complete. The following projects were added:

•	Pressler Junction Irrigation	\$ 10,000
•	Robbinsdale Park Restroom facility	\$175,000
•	Horace Mann Pool-Geo Tech Services	\$ 15,000
•	Meadowbrook Golf Course bridge renov.	\$ 50,000
•	Parkview parkland – Master Plan	\$ 10,000
•	Swim Center carpet replacement	\$ 25,000
•	Community Center Gyms-court dividers	\$ 32,000

The Omaha Street Founders Park Restroom Project, Bike Path Improvements project at the Fairgrounds, and the St. Joe Street Landscaping Enhancement project were moved to 2009 when additional funding will become available. The funding identified in 2007 for these projects was re-allocated to the new projects listed above.
