

Using the Tables and Map

The Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) tables display: Project Name, CIP Project Number, Years of Construction, Estimated Project Cost, the Department Driving the Project, and the Components of the Project. Two tables are provided. The first table is sorted alphabetically by the Project Name and the second table is sorted numerically by the CIP Project Number. The CIP Map displays the approximate location of the projects.

Alphabetical Listing

The table sorted alphabetically by Project Name is designed for the user to find the project that they are looking for by name and determine the CIP Project Number. Using the CIP Project Number, the user can go to the CIP Map and find the location of the project.

Numerical Listing

The table sorted by CIP Project Numbers is designed for the user to find a project on the CIP Map and take that number and go to the table. Once at the table sorted by number, the user can find the Project Name.

In both tables, the user can find the projected Years of Construction, the Estimated Cost of Construction, the Department Driving the Project, and the Components of the Project.
