Subject: Cemetery Rate Increase for 2008

Jeri Lynn Administrative Assistant (605) 394-5225 Summary: Cemetery Operations budget receives General Fund subsidy annually.

Recommendations: Park and Recreation staff recommend a 5% increase in

service fees as well as grave costs to help offset the general fund subsidy.

Analysis/Background: Cemetery fund is an enterprise budget. The revenue generated at the cemetery does not cover the operating expenses. Revenue

typically includes grave sales, grave opening and closing costs, monument setting fees and surcharge for Saturday or after hour services. An annual subsidy is needed to help cover the operational expenses.

In the last ten years we have asked council for a 5% increase in the grave costs and service fees with our goal to help maintain or to reduce the subsidy level. That level of future subsidy is difficult to quantify each year as revenue is based on the number of burials each year.

Expenses increase annually in salaries, utilities, fuel, and equipment maintenance costs. Contractual services for gate security, weekend gate (605) 394-5223 service, and the trend for more Saturday services increase the need for overtime compensation.

We see a small trend in subsidy reduction due in part to a modest increase in cemetery rates although competition with surrounding cemeteries makes it difficult for us to raise prices too dramatically as the customer will go somewhere else.
