NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the authority vested in them by SDCL 1-26, the South Dakota Transportation Commission will hold a public hearing at the Visitor Center on the Capitol Grounds in Pierre, South Dakota on **April 24, 2008** at 9:05 am (CDST) to consider the proposed amendments or additions to the following rule:

70:01:02:01(15) A speed zone in Minnehaha County on State Trunk Highway 264 is being repealed because the segment of highway referenced in the current rule has been removed from the state highway system.

70:01:02:36(9) A speed zone in Hughes County on SD Highway 1804 north of the city of Pierre is being amended to increase the allowable speed limit for traffic for a portion of this highway. This is being proposed to allow higher speeds through the area of recent reconstruction. The segment of highway with a 55 MPH limit will be shortened and a portion of this north of the Oahe Dam will be increased to 65 MPH.

70:01:02:65(3) A 45 MPH speed zone along U.S. Highway 18 in Shannon County is in place. The rule is being changed to reflect the true location of the limits of the reduced speed zone.

70:01:03:30 A proposed rule change is being made to correct the official highway identification which prohibits parking along the south side of State Trunk Highway 44 in Pennington County. The proposed rule change will remove reference to State Trunk Highway 79 which has been relocated to run concurrent with I-90 through Rapid City.

70:01:03:33 A proposed new rule is being made to prohibit parking along both sides of U.S. Highway 14A in Lawrence County. The proposed rule will prohibit parking along the shoulder of the road near Chop House south of Spearfish.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rule may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Transportation, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2586. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Transportation by **April 23, 2008**, to be considered.

After the hearing, the commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
