



This event consists of Little League All-Star teams from our region, competing for the privilege of advancing to the Midwest Regional Tournament and eventually the Little League World Series in Williamsport Pennsylvania. This event will bring a large number of people to this area for approximately one week. Parking is at a premium in this area and in an effort to protect players and pedestrians alike, Rushmore Little League is requesting permission to close Herman St between E.Chicago and E.New York St. This stretch of road is one city block long. The street would be closed approximately one hour prior to the first games of the day and would be re-opened soon after the last game. Other than several sets of barricades, no additional resources would be required to make this happen.
