Call To Order

Loeschke called the meeting to order at 7:31 a.m.

Schwiesow requested final approval of the remodel project and briefly reviewed the revised window locations and the revised garage and house elevations.

Elkins explained that the original project went to the State for their determination based on the Committee's adverse recommendation. She added that the State determined that the project did have an adverse effect. Schwiesow's submitted the plans to the City Council for determination that all feasible and prudent alternatives had been met.
