## AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE CITY COUNCIL TO DETERMINE THE COMPOSITION OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEES REQUIRED BY THE 2012 PROGRAM BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 3.16.020(E) OF THE RAPID CITY MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Council have previously amended the process for adopting projects to be included in a 2012 five year plan; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the structure of the committees should be altered; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it in the best interests of the City to retain flexibility in establishing the composition of the Citizen Committees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Rapid City Common Council that Rapid City Municipal Code subsection 3.16.020(E) is hereby amended to read as follows:
E. Prior to the adoption of a 5-year plan and, for 5-year plans to be adopted subsequent to 2005, after approval of the resolution described in subsection C. of this section, the Mayor shall appoint, with the consent of the Council, a Municipal Infrastructure Committee, a Civic Improvement Committee and an Economic Development Committee. The Council shall, by resolution, determine the number of members of eEach committee, shall consist of 9 members and all committee members must be whe residents of the city. No member shall serve on more than one committee. Each committee shall elect a chair. Each committee shall hold at least 2 public hearings, giving 10 days notice in the legal newspaper of the city, to take public comment on how the funds identified within the committee's category should be expended. After taking the public input, each committee shall make its recommendation to the Council for the expenditure of the funds within its category within the next 5-year plan. Each committee's recommendation shall consist of a list of projects, with the estimated cost of each project included in the recommendation.
