Comparable land sales Indicate that lots in the area generally sell from \$11,000 to \$36,000 with the higher end in the newer subdivisions at the northern edge of town and the lower end appear to generally be difficult or unbuildable lots. Lot size adjutments or residential lots are generally not based on a per sit or per acre price, but generally based the amount of surplus land on one buildable lot. In general, largest portion of a lot's value is given to the building site and a smaller value for surplus land. The adjustment used for the market grid are at \$5,000/ac are made based on the market value of surplus land which generally is not subdividable and is value is based on the law of diminishing value as the excess acreage increases, it is worth less to the average residential buyer.

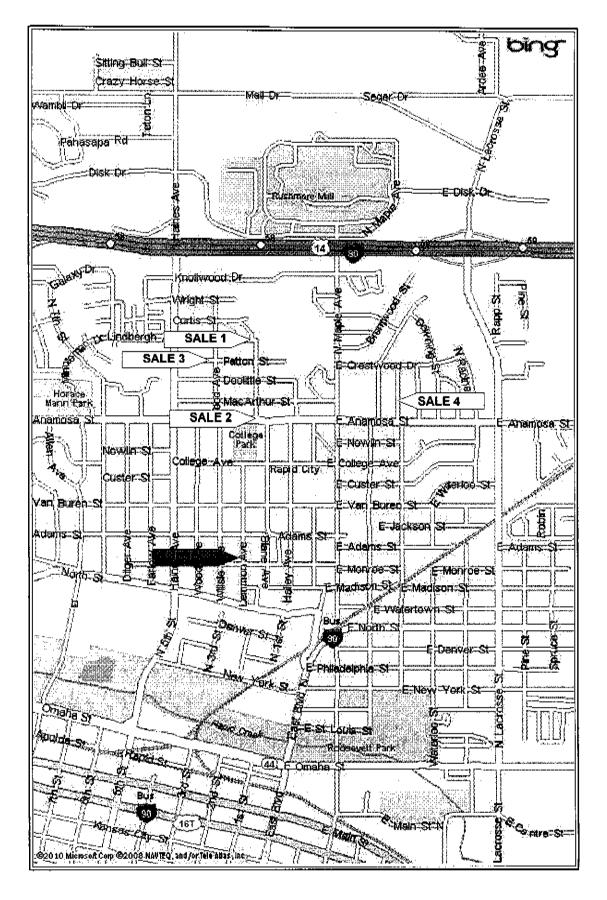

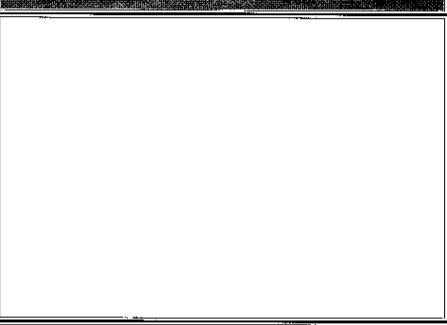

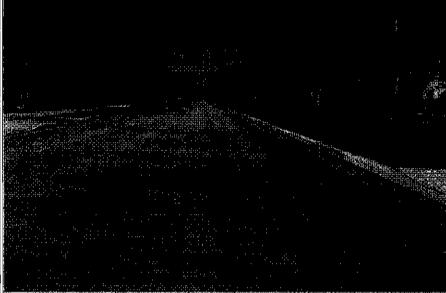


FRONT OF SUBJECT PROPERTY 706 Lemmon Avenue Rapid City, SD 57747
