The Big Y Youth Triathlon. May 25th 2013

Purpose: To promote youth wellness through friendly competition.

Location: Rapid City YMCA. Race HQ and transition area will be the Bus parking lot next the Y house. Racers will enter 9th street from this location.

Time: Race starts at 7:30. Transition area opens at 6:30

Race Route. Bike race is out and back on 9th Street. Running race is on sidewalks. 9th street, Columbus st, West blvd, and Kansas city st.

Entrants: Max 70. Age range 3 to 13

Support needed. Street barricades to block 9th street from Kansas City St to Quincy st. The alley from 8th st to 9th street will need to be blocked. 9th street south to Franklin st would be closed to ensure the safety of the participants. Cones to mark the race course on 9th street. I will have volunteer crossing guards at all intersections on 9th street on the bike course.

The transition area and race HQ will open at 6:30. This is the time when all the races will setup their bikes and running gear. This is in the bus parking lot next to the Y house. All racers enter the race course from this area. The first main intersection to be crossed is 9th and Quincy st. Bikers will be using the road and runners will use sidewalks. Bikers will ride south on 9th street to a turnaround spot. Each age group rides a different length course. Some age groups will do 2 laps of the bike course. 9th street would need to be closed during the bike portion of the Tri. The turn around spot for the bike course is at Franklin street and the road would need to be closed up to Franklin. Barricades would be needed for 8 intersections. Volunteers will be manning all closures on the bike course. When the last biker completes the course the barricades will be removed. All bikers should be done by 9:00 and runners by 10:00 am. Course teardown will begin at 10:00 am.

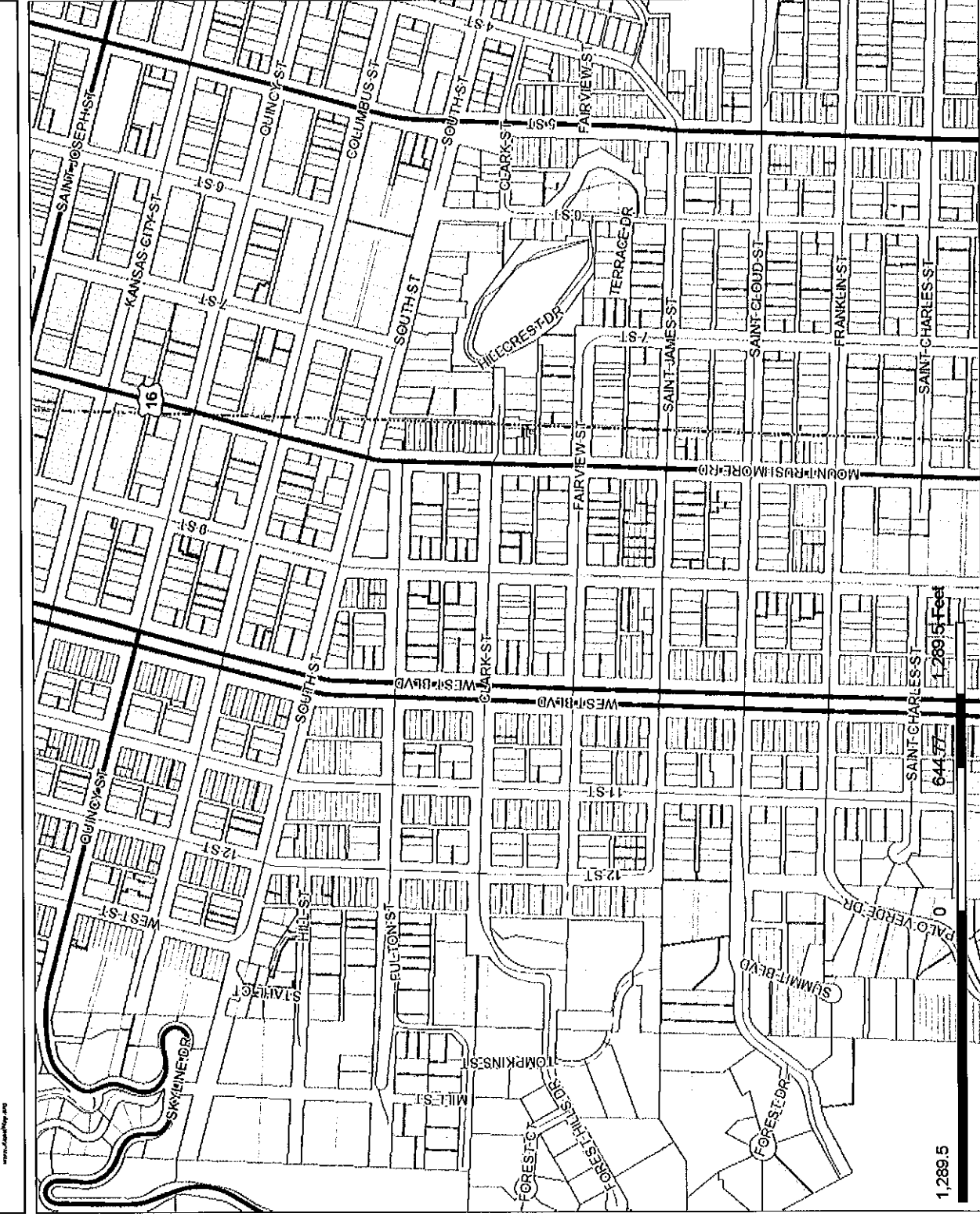
Race Courses. Bike course is in Red and the run course is in Blue. The Bike course will be on 9th and ridden in the road. It is an out and back style course. The Run course will use sidewalks. Volunteer Crossing guards will be posted at each intersection and bike patrol will be on the bike course. The Racers will enter the course on 9th street beside the ymca.

Race main transition area is the YMCA Bus parking lot. 9th Street will need to be blocked at the 2 red lines above. The bike section of the course will be on 9th street and is an out and back bike course. The running section of the race will be on the sidewalks on 9th st. West Blvd, Columbus St, and Kansas City St. The race will begin at 7:30 am and should be all done and everyone off the course by 10 am. 9th street should be blocked by 6 am to ensure that the street will be free of any vehicles. I will have volunteer crossing guards at all intersection as well as bike patrol on 9th street.
