Youth & Family Services is requesting authorization to conduct a raffle. We will be doing a fundraiser to benefit the YFS Girls Incorporated program. It is called "Helping with Horsepower" and would have 15-20 GI members help provide hands-on repairs on the bike, do some paint design, and also learn about budgeting and marketing. Black Hills Harley Davidson has donated a 2012 Harley Heritage Soft-Tail from their rental fleet. The girls will customize the bike with different parts, paint design, etc. Harley Davidson of the Black Hills will ensure the bike is mechanically sound after it is reassembled.

The Hot Rod Institute has agreed to allow the girls to work at their facility over a 20-week process. In June, promotions would start for the selling of raffle tickets and would involve members of Zonta of the Black Hills organization, YFS Inc and YFS Foundation Board Members, YFS staff, and Black Hills Harley Davidson. Tickets will be \$20 each or 3 for \$50 and will be sold throughout the Black Hill area and also during the Sturgis Rally. The winner will be announced at the annual Zonta Expo in October.
