


Map 3. Recommended Bikeways





  - Brookdale Estates Mobile Home Park nearly 200 homes
- 4) Bus Stop on Cambell Street
- Currently Only <u>ONE</u> Mode of Transportation By Vehicle
  - No sidewalks or public transit extend to these places
- Utilize a signalized intersection to cross Omaha
- Future sidewalk in-fills would tie into project
