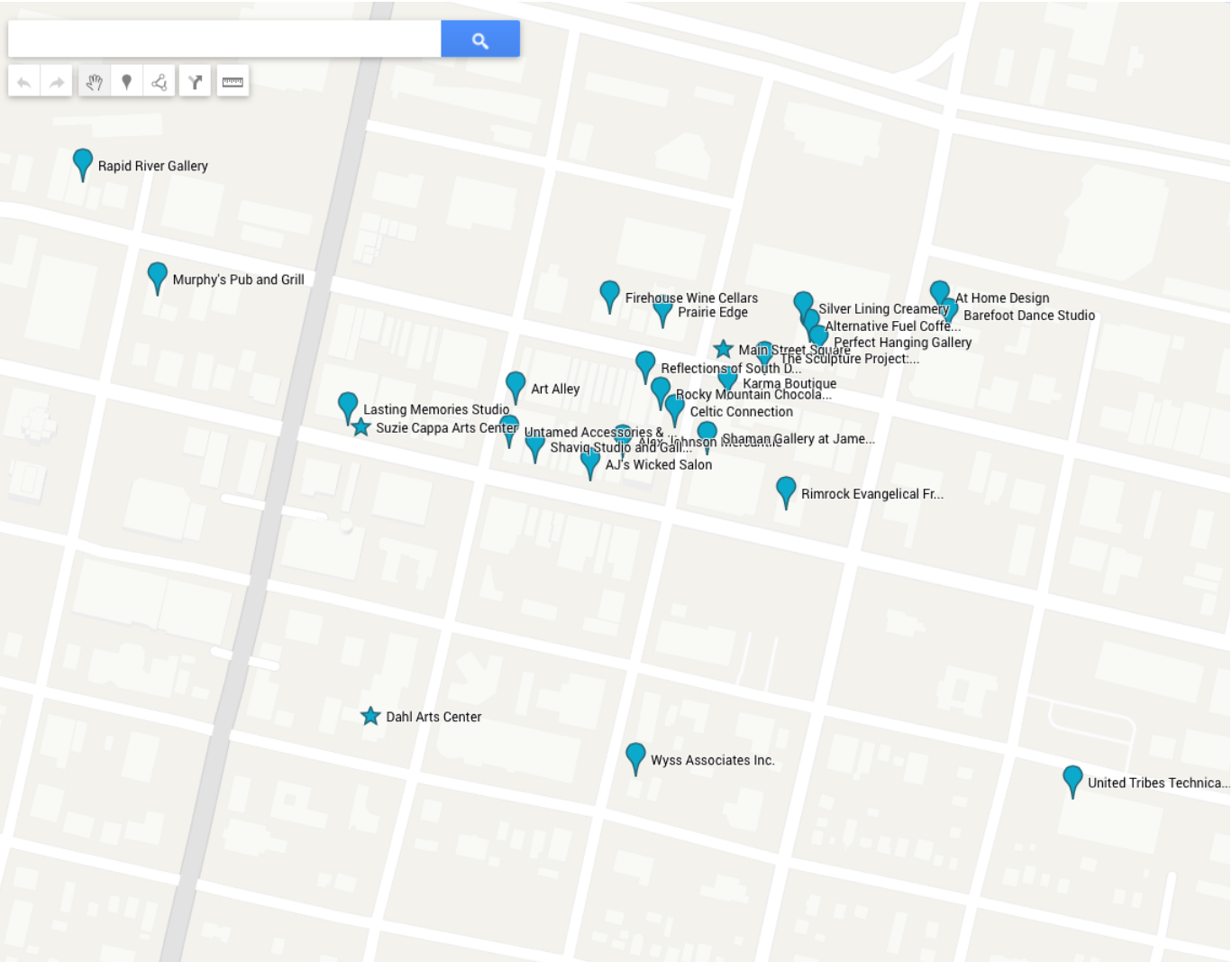

## **POP-UP Park Concept**

The pop-up park is a temporary streetscape that creates an instant pocket park. The concept of the pop-up park grew out of the pavement-to-parks movement in New York and San Francisco. The creation was a “parklet”, which is a cross between a terrace cafe and a pocket park that occupies one or two curbside parking spaces. In our Art Night parklet's case, we are utilizing 3 parking stalls. The Art Night Parklet will have a combination of seating and sculpture with tree and ornamental grasses for vegetative buffer. The parklet will utilize both recycled and new materials for the overall construction. We are planning that this parklet be of modular construction, meaning that it will be constructed off-site and assembled on site. Our group plans to assembled the parklet Friday, June 13th and removed it the following Wednesday.

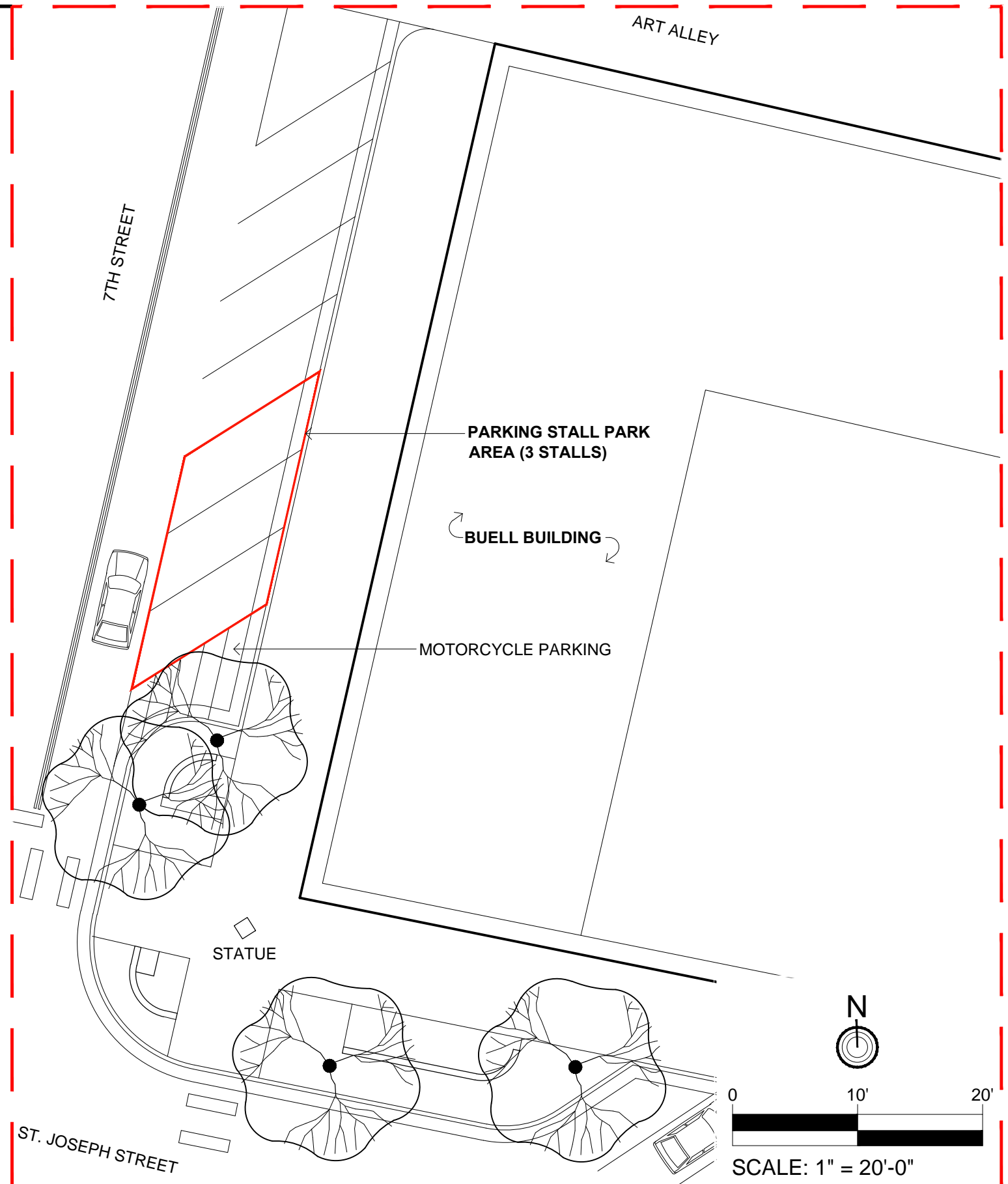
