Pursuant to a motion made and passed at Rapid City Planning Commission May 7, 2015 a request is made to be placed on the May 13 Legal and Finance Agenda regarding adding language to the proposed ordinance revision of Section 3.16.090 CIP Committee: ***RE: The Rapid City Planning Commission shall annually designate a liaison from the Planning Commission to the Committee membership.***

Relevance: The CIP determines the budgeting and priority if infrastructure projects approximating \$125,000,000 over a five year outlook for Rapid City. Decisions at Planning Commission approving development are financially tied to the infrastructure expenditures determined by the CIP Committee. Because flexibility is required and CIP budget priorities are subject to change from time to time the Planning Commission should remain a member of the CIP Committee.
