RESOLUTION No. 2015-111 RESOLUTION TO APPROVE 2016 PLAN DESIGN CHANGES FOR CITY OF RAPID CITY HEALTHCARE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Healthcare Committee voted on October 15, 2015 to recommend the City amend its healthcare plan design with Wellmark BlueCross Blue Shield to comply with the South Dakota Legislative Mandate in regard to Oral Chemotherapy (effective January 1, 2016), which states in part that any health plan that provides benefits for injected or intravenously administered cancer treatment medication shall provide no less favorable benefits for prescribed, orally administered anticancer medication; and

WHEREAS, after an analysis of different options concluded that the City would adjust its pharmacy out of pocket maximum to \$1800 to match the current health insurance out of pocket maximum; and

WHEREAS, the Healthcare Committee voted on July 16, 2015 to recommend the City amend its healthcare plan design with Wellmark BlueCross Blue Shield to increase the annual preventative care maximum to keep pace with medical inflation; and

WHEREAS, the annual preventative benefit maximum will be 75% of single premium effective January 1, 2016

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rapid City to adopt the aforementioned plan design changes
