The Model

The input-output model for this information is from Economic Modeling Specialists International EMSI's gravitational flows multi-regional social account matrix model (MR-SAM).

It is based on data from the Census Bureau's Current Population Survey and American Community Survey; as well as the Bureau of Economic Analysis' National Income and Product Accounts, Input-Output Make and Use Tables, and Gross State Product data. In addition, several EMSI in-house data sets are used, as well as data from Oak Ridge National Labs on the cost of transportation between counties. This report uses state data from the South Dakota Department of Labor, Labor Market Information Division.
