## **SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION**

Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan

On November 3, 2003, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the Comprehensive Plan by changing the future land use designation on a 4.04 acre parcel of land from General Commercial with a Planned Commercial Development to Office Commercial with a Planned Commercial Development on a previously unplatted parcel of land in the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 26, T1N, R7E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota; being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the found corner stamped R.L.S. 4208 of the center 1/4 corner of Section 26; thence S42°17'28"W along a nonvisual line, 1733.45 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence N01°18'09"E 924.20 feet; thence S88°41'51"E 238.42 feet; thence S06°15'29"W 87.98 feet; thence S01°18'09"W 400.00 feet; thence S31°04'35"W 503.44 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; said parcel containing 4.04 acres more or less.
