Wed 12/10 Sorry to be late. I was looking into this issue this afternoon so your reminder is timely.

As you know, our policy for decades has been that we want nothing on our side of the fence and that infrastructure, roads, etc should remain on the developer's side of the fence or even off the section line. The water tank is clearly an exception to this and is being investigated as a learning experience for us. I don't really need another exception at this time so we would like to maintain our fenceline philosophy which means that the drainage dam, backup, everything should not be premised on being on our land in any manner at any time even the remote chance of water backup on our land.
