SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION

Amendment to the Future Land Use Plan Comprehensive Plan

On December 5, 2005, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the future land use designation from General Agriculture to Office Commercial on a parcel of land described as beginning at the southwest corner of Lot B of the SW1/4, Section 14, T1N, R7E, BHM, less lot H-1, Lot B, which is a concrete highway right-of-way monument, which is the true point of beginning: Thence; N05°30'18"E, a distance of 252.53 feet, Thence; N89°45'39"E, a distance of 127.81 feet, Thence; S14°14'34"W, a distance of 289.32 feet, Thence; N70°33'57"W, a distance of 85.74 feet, to the true point of beginning; all located in the SW1/4, Section 14, T1N, R7E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota; containing 0.652 acres more or less.
