**SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION**  
Rapid City Major Street Plan Amendment  
Comprehensive Plan Amendment

On 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2006, the Rapid City Council approved a revision to the Rapid City Major Street Plan as an amendment to the Rapid City Comprehensive Plan. This revision included Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan by relocating a collector street on the Major Street Plan located in Lot 1 of Neff's Subdivision No. 3, and the unplatted land in the W1/2 SW1/4, Section 34, T2N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota. The Major Street Plan is used to guide the planning of the street network in Rapid City and surrounding area and is necessary for the preservation of street right-of-way for proposed collector and arterial streets. Copies of the Comprehensive Plan, the Major Street Plan, and amendments are available for public inspection at the Rapid City Finance Office, 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, South Dakota during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
