COMMISSION ACTIVITY

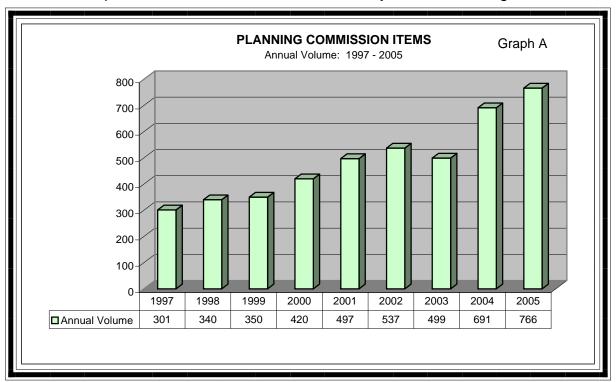

COMMISSION ACTIVITY

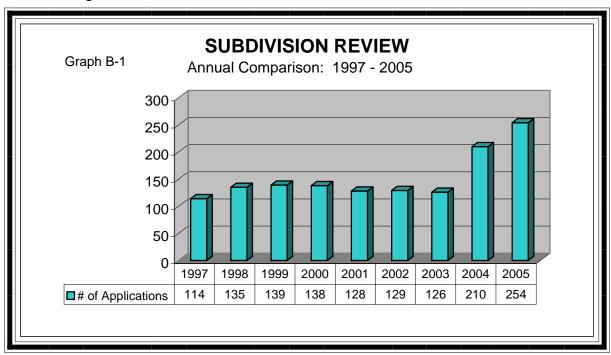
The Planning Commission scheduled a total of 29 meetings during the course of 2005, 23 regular meetings, three continued meetings and three special meetings dedicated to the following issues: Canyon Lake Overlay District, microcell antennas, and the North Rapid work release/detention facility. A total of 766 new items were considered during the 2005 meetings. The items considered during 2005 included Conditional Use Permit, Rezoning, Planned Development, Plat (Layout and Preliminary) Final Plat, Minor Plat, Vacation (Right of Way and Easement), Variance (Subdivision and Fence), Ordinance Amendment, Annexation, Comprehensive Plan Amendment, SDCL 11-6-19 and Other. **Table 1** provides a breakdown of these items. It should be noted that the Minor and Final Plat actions reflected below represent the Final Plat approval of 947 individual lots. Two training sessions were scheduled during 2005 to provide the Planning Commission members with an indepth training on various aspects of planning and zoning issues.

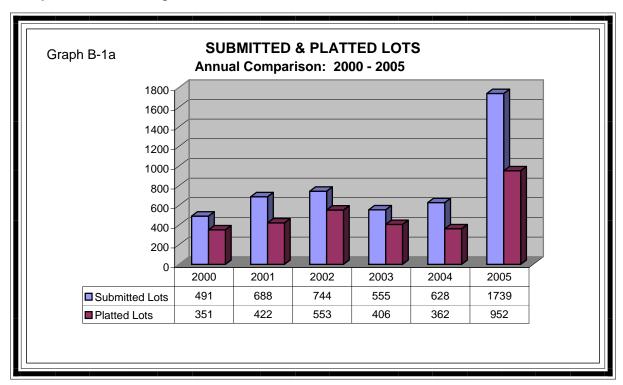
GRAPH A depicts the volume of items heard for the years 1997 through 2005.



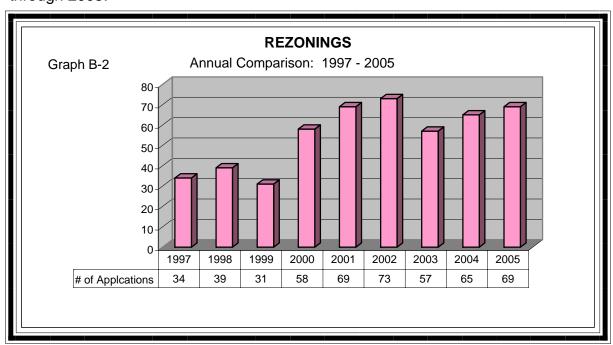
Graph B-1 provides a comparison of the Subdivision Review activity for the years 1997 through 2005.



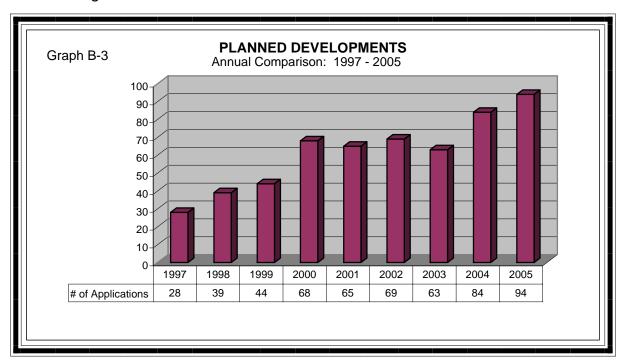
Graph B-1a provides a comparison of the submitted lot and platted lot activity for the years 2000 through 2005.



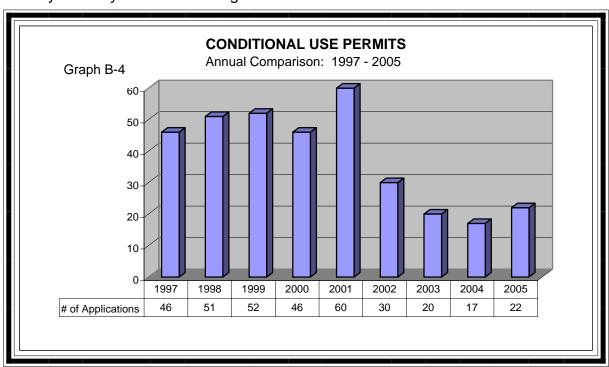
Graph B-2 provides a comparison of the Rezoning activity for the years 1997 through 2005.



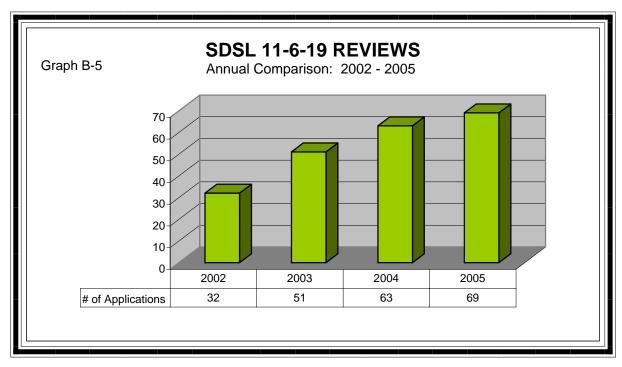
Graph B-3 provides a comparison of the Planned Development activity for the years 1997 through 2005.

Graph B-5 provides a comparison of SDCL 11-6-19 Reviews addressed for the years 2002 through 2005.

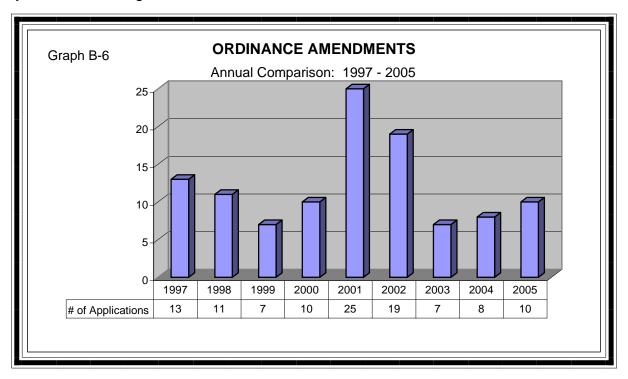


SECTION 11-6-19

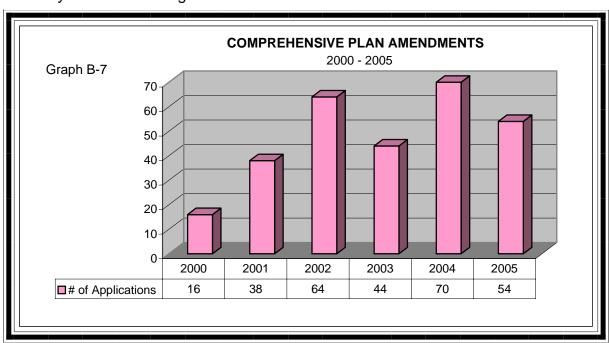
Planning Commission approval required for construction in area covered by Comprehensive Plan. Whenever any such municipal council shall have adopted the Comprehensive Plan of the municipality or any part thereof, then and thenceforth, no street, park, or other public way, ground, place, space, no public building or structure, no public utility, whether publicly or privately owned, if covered by the Comprehensive Plan or any adopted part thereof, shall be constructed or authorized in the municipality or within its subdivision jurisdiction as defined in § 11-6-26, until and unless the location and extent thereof shall have been submitted to and approved by the Planning Commission.

As a municipality with an adopted Comprehensive Plan, the City of Rapid City is required to comply with the provisions of SDCL 11-6-19. The impact of this law is reflected in the continued increase in activity experienced by the Planning Commission in 2003 through 2005. A total of sixty-nine (69) SDCL 11-6-19 applications were processed in 2005. It is anticipated that the activity levels of this category will remain at or increase above the current levels in future years.

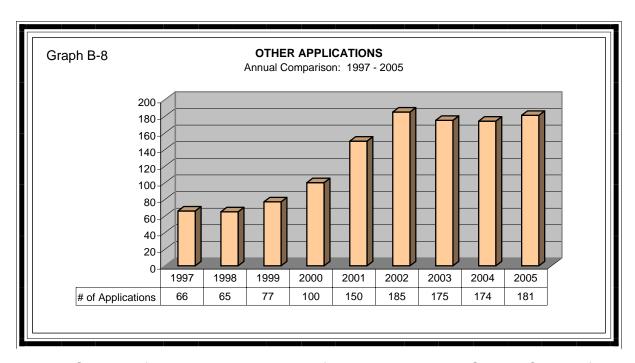
Graph B-6 provides a comparison of the Ordinance Amendment activity for the years 1997 through 2005.



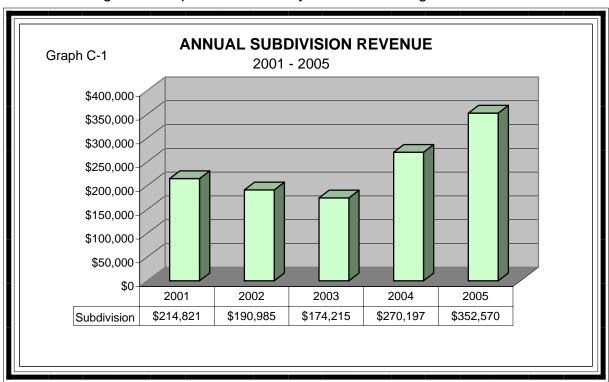
GRAPH B-7 provides a comparison of the Comprehensive Plan Amendment activity for the years 2000 through 2005.



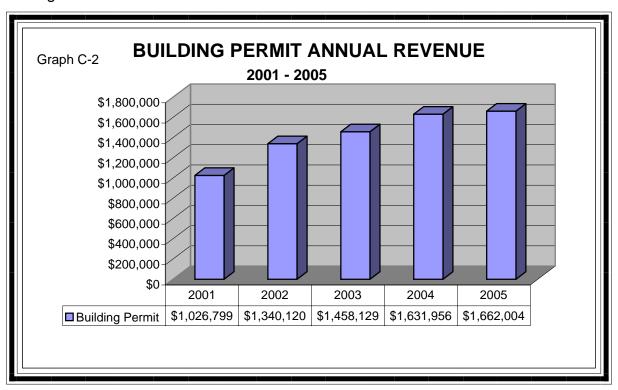

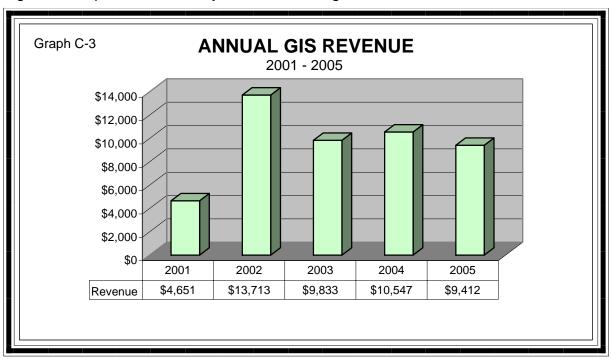
Graph C-1 identifies the Annual Revenue for the Development Service Center of the Growth Management Department for the years 2001 through 2005.



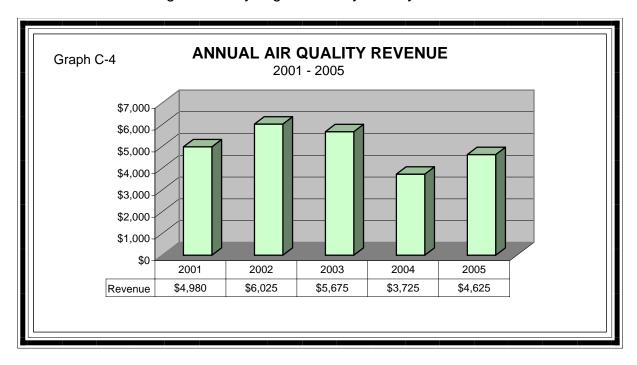
Graph C-2 identifies the annual revenue for the Building Inspections Division of the Growth Management Department for the years 2001 – 2005. With the reorganization the Building Permit Review Center was incorporated into the Growth Management Department. Responsibilities of this Division include the issuance of building permits, review of building plans for compliance with zoning requirements and on-site inspections to insure work conforms to adopted building codes. 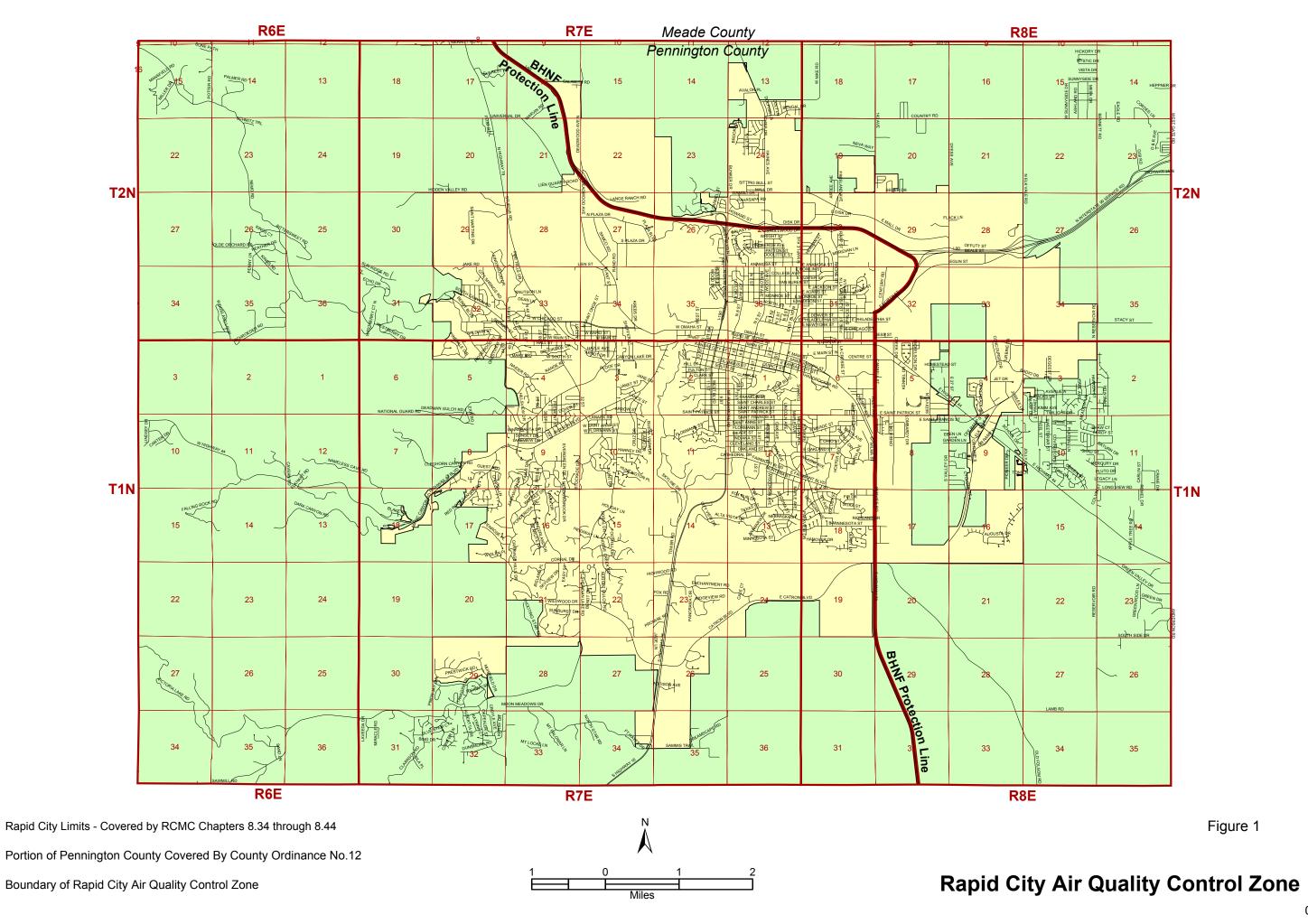


Graph C-3 identifies the Annual Revenue for the GIS Division of the Growth Management Department for the years 2001 through 2005.

During 2005 the Air Quality Division issued sixty-seven (67) Air Quality Construction Permits, three (3) Parking Lot Permits and processed forty-seven (47) complaint calls. Figures 1 provides the boundary of the Rapid City Air Quality Control Zone. That area contained within the boundaries of the City of Rapid City is governed by the Rapid City Municipal Code, Chapters 8.34 through 8.44. That area contained within the unincorporated area of Pennington County is governed by County Ordinance No. 12.





2005 ANNEXATION ACTIVITY

Acknowledging the significant growth occurring beyond the corporate limits of the City, the City Council adopted the following annexation goals:

- The annexation of lands which are necessary for the orderly growth and development of the City;
- The annexation of lands which are urbanized or urbanizing to the extent that they require an urban level of services;
- The annexation of lands, the development of which effect the health and/or safety of the residents of the City; and,
- The annexation of lands to ensure an equitable tax base.

In addition to adopting the preceding goals the City Council also established the following short-term and long-term annexation priorities

- 7 Cambell East (completed in 2001 @ 77.272 acres);

- 8 South East Connector (partially completed 2003 @ 133.4682 acres);
- 9 South Cambell Street (partially completed in 2002 @ 62.87 acres; balance completed July 7, 2004 @ 173.3221 acres);
- 10 North Valley Drive (partially completed December 3, 2004 @ 1.31 acres);
- 11 Pioneer Drive; and,
- 12 School Drive (partially completed May 24, 2005 @ .36 acres)

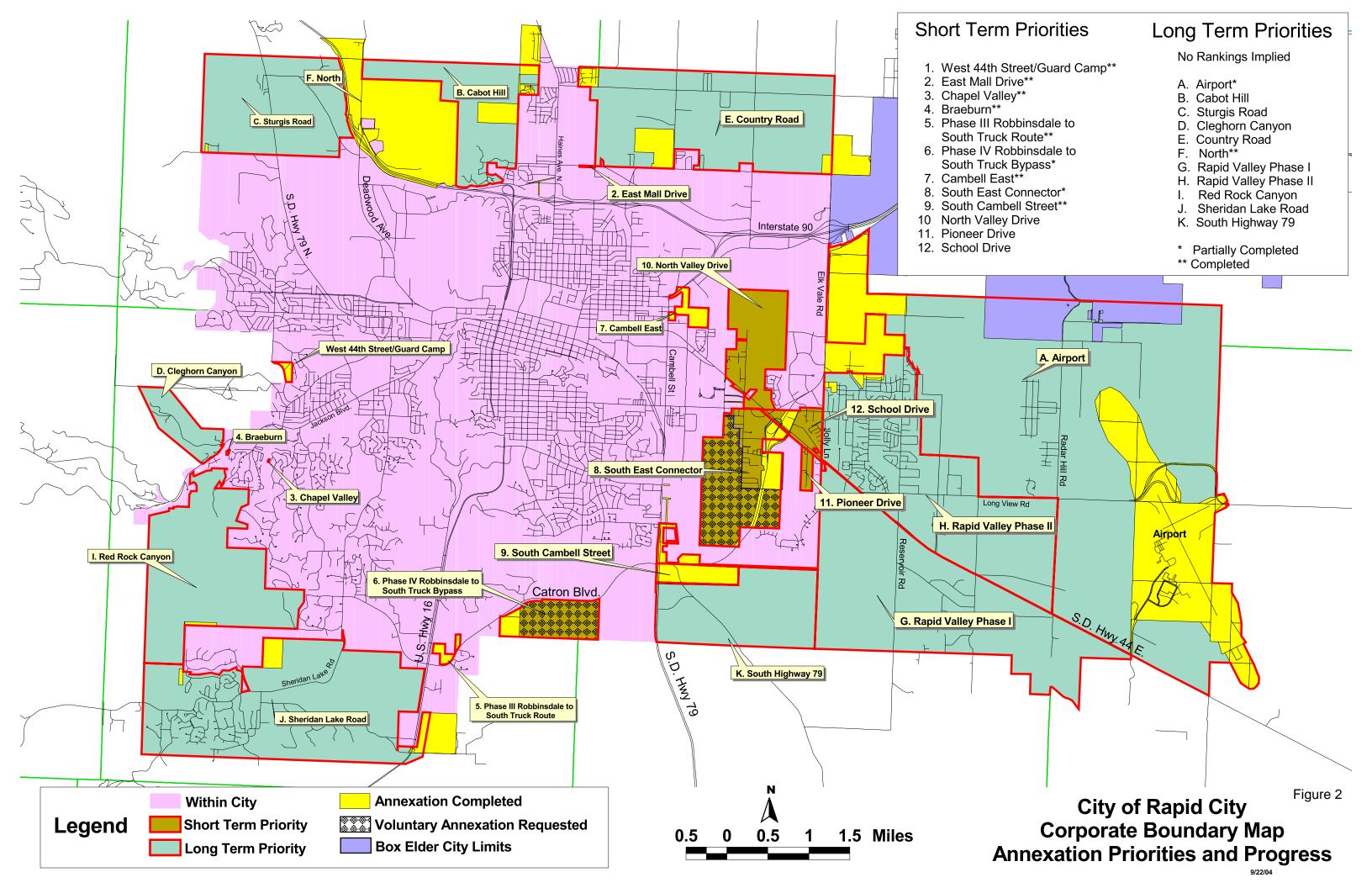

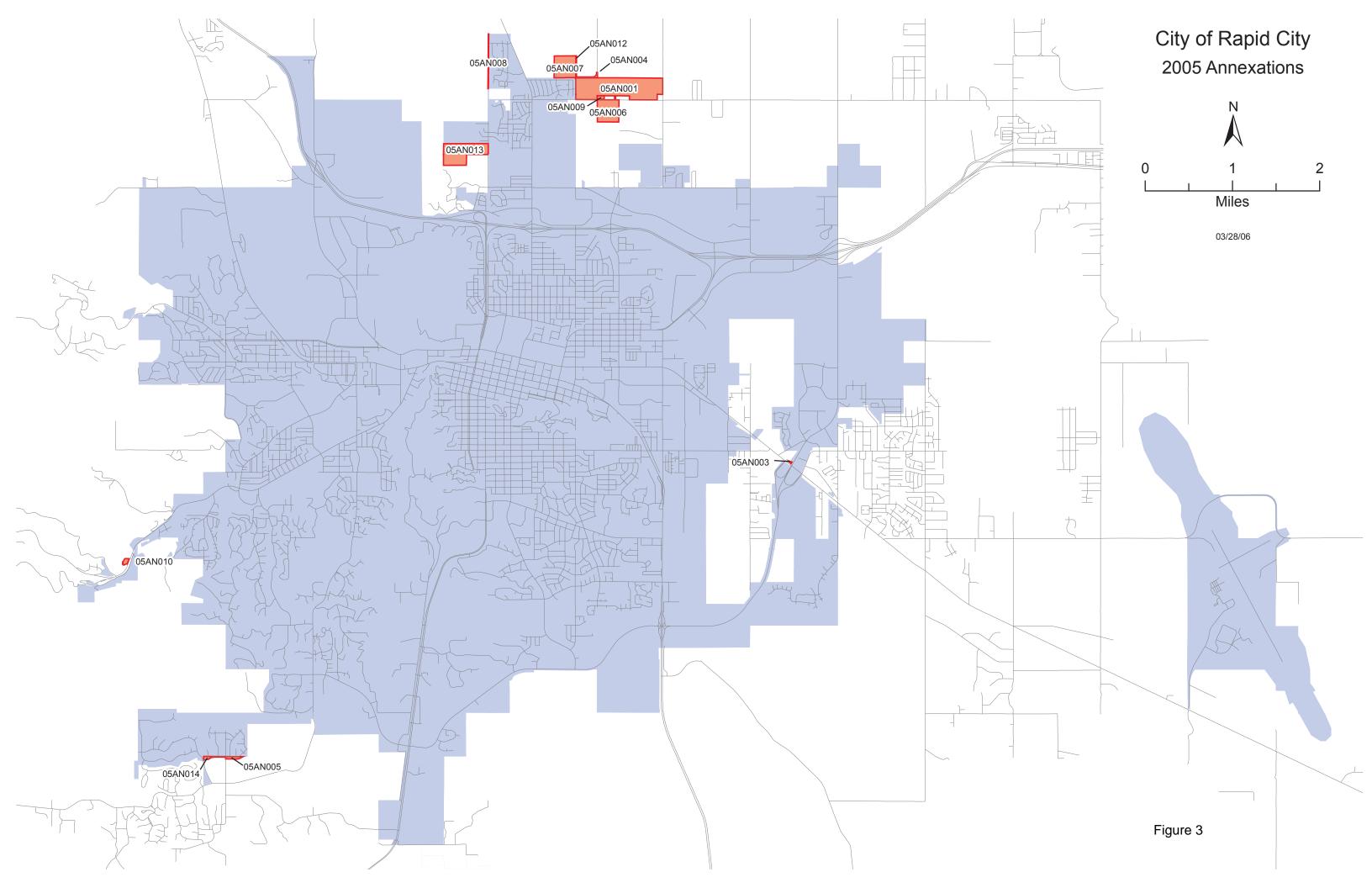

TAX INCREMENT FINANCING

Tax Increment Financing is a vehicle by which improvements and development in blighted areas are financed. This financing method is invaluable for encouraging growth and development in areas with special development problems. The following districts were adopted, revised or dissolved during 2005:

ADOPTED DISTRICTS

- District #52 Approved in May, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #52 will facilitate the development of property adjacent to East St. Charles Street through the extension of E. St. Charles Street, the development of drainage improvements and the possible reclamation of a City snow dump site. The street and public improvements will enhance the ability of new development to occur thereby increasing the community's economic vitality and expand the City's property tax base. The District will incorporate approximately 26.2 acres north of East St. Patrick Street, west of Creek Drive and east of Cambell Street. It is anticipated that one or more of the properties in the proposed District will be used for commercial purposes allowing the District to qualify as an Economic Development Tax Increment District and will not require an additional levy for the School District share of property taxes. Tax Increment District #52 is developer financed. (05TI001/05TI002)
- ◆ District #53 Approved in July, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #53 will facilitate the development of the Stoney Creek Plaza located on the southeast corner of Catron Boulevard and Sheridan Lake Road by providing storm water drainage improvements to include a box culvert and associated grading. The District will incorporate approximately 12.5 acres and will enhance the ability of new development to occur thereby increasing the community's economic viability and expanding the City's tax base. It is anticipated that one or more of the properties in the proposed District will be used for commercial purposes allowing the District to qualify as an Economic Development Tax Increment District and will not require an additional levy for the School District share of property taxes. Tax Increment District #53 is developer financed. (05TI006/05TI007)
- District #54 Approved in October, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #54 will facilitate the development of a well, booster station and water mains and park improvements to City park land. The District will encompass an area extending from north of Mall Drive and west of Haines Avenue and the improvements will result in an expanded developable area thereby expanding the City's property tax base and will benefit all citizens by improving City park land. Tax Increment District #54 is developer financed. (05TI008/05TI009)

Tax Increment Financing

- ◆ District #55 Approved in October, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #55 will facilitate the development of public improvements for a lift station to serve Freeland Meadows Subdivision and other adjacent areas of development. The District will encompass an area extending from the western boundary of Auburn Hills Subdivision and along Country Road to 143rd Avenue including 40 acres of the Northbrook Village Subdivision and will enhance the ability of new development to occur in this area increasing the community's economic vitality and expanding the City's property tax base. Tax Increment District #55 is developer and City financed respectively. (05TI011/05TI012)
- ◆ District #56 Approved in November, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #56 will fund public improvements to serve a new commercial development located south of Interstate 90 and north of East Anamosa Street between LaCrosse Street and East North Street. Phase I will address the reconstruction of Farnwood/Eglin Street from LaCrosse Street to Spruce Street and from Spruce Street to East North Street, the installation of traffic signals, a regional drainage detention dam, the relocation of power lines, high pressure water main and sanitary sewer main. Phase II improvements will include the construction of a north-south road lying between East Anamosa Street. It is anticipated that one or more of the properties in the proposed District will be used for commercial purposes allowing the District to qualify as an Economic Development Tax Increment District and will not require an additional levy for the School District share of property taxes. Tax Increment District #56 is developer and City financed respectively. (05TI013/05TI014)
- ◆ District #58 Denied in December, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #58 proposed the development of the Black Hills Center through the public improvements for Stumer Road, Black Hills Boulevard, traffic lights, turn lane and water and sewer improvements adjacent to Catron Boulevard and Fifth Street. Tax Increment District Project Plan #41 was revised to incorporate the Project Costs proposed by Revisions #1 and #2. The Project Costs proposed by Revisions #1 and #2 of Tax Increment District #41 are developer financed. (05TI017/05TI018)

REVISED DISTRICTS

◆ District #36 - Approved in June, 2005, the revised Project Plan for Tax Increment District #36 assists with the extension of water and sanitary sewer, relocation of pipeline and the costs of Disk Drive roadway improvements west of Haines Avenue and assists with the costs of water, sewer, road, and storm drainage improvements associated with the park to the north and will provide a landscape buffer. Tax Increment District #36 boundaries were not expanded

with the Project Plan revisions and the total costs of the Project Plan were not changed. Phase I of the Project Plan is City financed; Phase II of the Project Plan is developer financed. (05TI003)

- District #41 –Tax Increment District #41 Project Plan was revised twice during 2005. Revision #1 proposed the addition of project costs for the construction of a lift station and force main and was approved in June, 2005. Revision #2 proposed the addition of project costs for 5th Street Extension, extraordinary grading costs, Parkview Drive street, utility and related storm drainage improvements, oversizing costs of streets, traffic signals, turn lanes, and sewer and water improvements and the design costs for the lift station approved in Revision #2 and was approved in December, 2005. Tax Increment District #41 boundaries were not expanded with the Project Plan revisions. Tax Increment District Revisions #1 and #2 are developer financed. (05TI004/05TI005)
- ◆ District #50 Approved in November, 2005, the revised Project Plan for Tax Increment District #50 assists with the acquisition, demolition, cleanup and redevelopment of the former Federal Beef meat packing plant property and off-site water improvements to assist in the redevelopment of the area, signalization of the 12th Street/Omaha Street intersection, reconstruction of Philadelphia Street to a new location, Rapid Creek pedestrian crossing at Rapid Creek and 12th Street and rehabilitation of the hydroelectric plant at an unidentified cost. It is anticipated that one or more of the properties in the proposed District will be used for commercial purposes allowing the District to qualify as an Economic Development Tax Increment District and will not require an additional levy for the School District share of property taxes. Project costs for District #50 are developer and City financed respectively. (05TI010)

DISSOLVED DISTRICTS

- ◆ District #18 Dissolved February, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District #18 provided for the purchase of land to assist Horizon's Incorporated in the expansion of their operations in the Rushmore Regional Industrial Park. This District was dissolved as all of the project costs have been repaid. (771)
- District #34 Dissolved December, 2005, Tax Increment Financing District # 34 provided for the extension of City water underneath U.S. Interstate 90 to serve the commercial/light industrial development in the Deadwood Avenue area north of the Interstate Highway and facilitate the relocation and expansion of Black Hills Harley-Davidson/Buell. This District was dissolved as all of the project costs have been repaid. (01TI008)
- District #57 The Resolution Creating Tax Increment Financing District #57

was approved in December, 2005 and subsequently dissolved in February, 2006. The associated Project Plan was denied in February, 2006. The Project Plan proposed to assist with residential and commercial development in the Plum Creek area by funding public improvements including grading and storm drainage improvements along East Minnesota Street and the frontage road. (05TI015/05TI016)

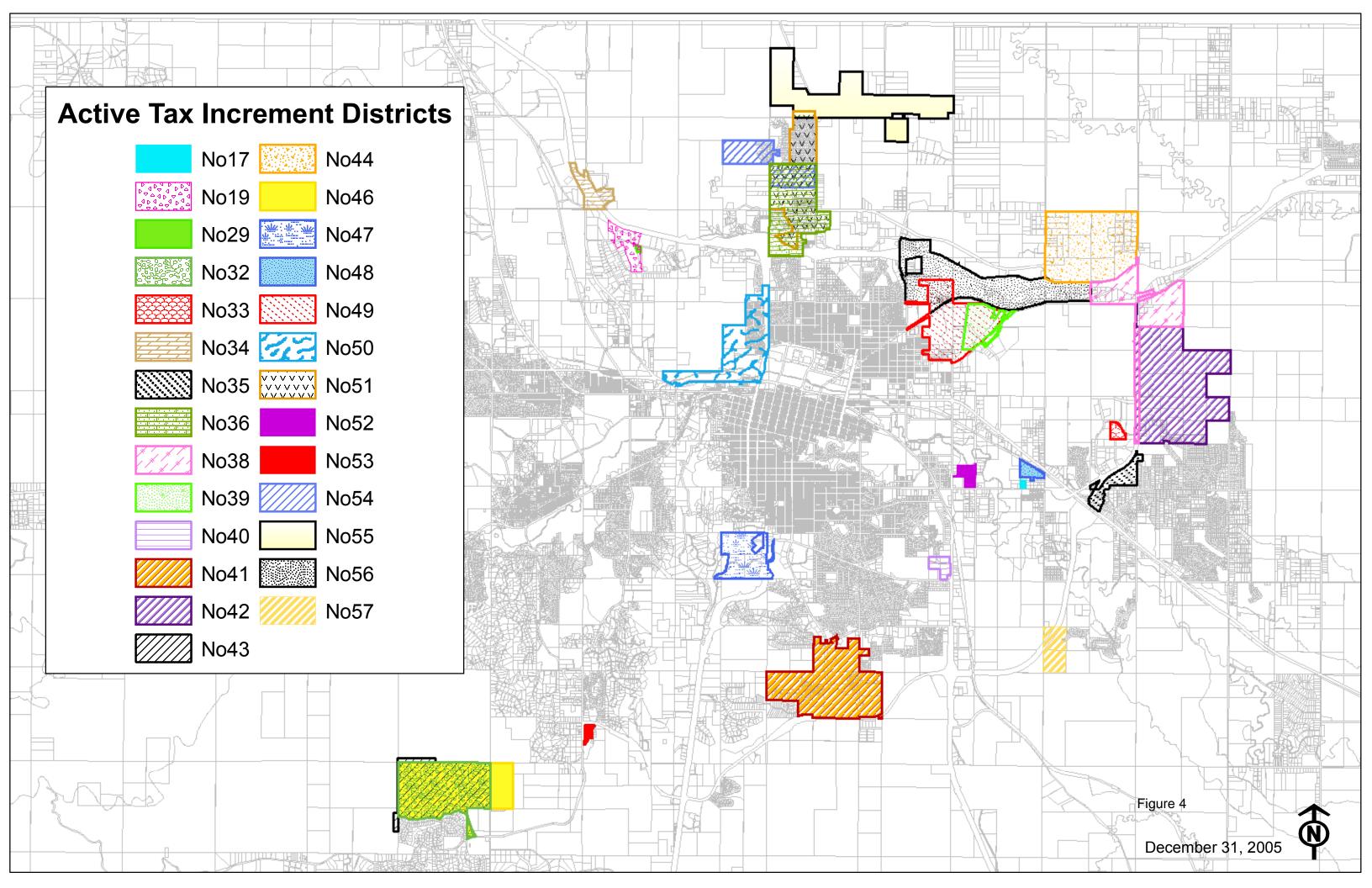

GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS)

GIS activities for 2005 proceeded along two major courses: the preparation of data for use in the E911 system, and the continuing conversion of older user applications to the new Windows-based software, along with the writing of new applications.

A large amount of GIS staff time was used to analyze and update the road centerline and address point data sets for the E911 system. At some point, all the GIS staff worked on this project. The original road and address range information came from a system with an underlying data structure that was not completely compatible with the GIS, thus numerous small errors were introduced during the conversion. The data for the entire county was checked road by road for names and address range information. Address points associated with each road were also checked. Data for each of the incorporated towns in Pennington County were checked in cooperation with the towns. Towns were provided with large scale maps showing addresses, parcels, and roads. Additionally, an interactive map using the internet was created for each town, providing them a way to submit changes and new addresses directly to the GIS Division. A number of analyses were produced to find problems in the data. These included checks for overlapping address

ranges, and duplicate roads and ranges. Once the data set was put in use by the dispatch center, GIS personnel provided daily support for any addresses that would not match, although these problems proved to be minimal.

applications Numerous were upgraded or written during 2005. Among these were a mapping and search tool for the City Cemetery. The tool will allow cemetery staff to quickly identify grave locations. The County Auditor's office was provided with an updated tool for assigning voting precincts to new applicants or for those affected by redrawn precinct boundaries. As part of the E911 data update, programs were written to allow the easy conversion of GIS data for the new system. Other tools included a new traffic accident mapping application, and City zoning and future land use maintenance tools.

Other work completed in 2005 included a major software documentation project and several analyses. Analyses included a series of response time maps for the City Fire Department for testing various locations for new fire stations. Another analysis for the Fire Department involved distance studies for new stations relative to the locations of existing fire hydrants. Tax increment district map layers

were created in a separate project for the City Finance Department.

TRANSPORTATION STUDIES

Rapid City Area 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan

The Rapid City Area 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan is the transportation planning document that is the backbone for transportation planning activities and transportation facility development. The goal of the Long Range Transportation Plan is to plan system improvements to achieve an multi-modal transportation system that maximizes the safe and efficient movement of goods and people, and minimizes resource expenditures, energy consumption, and pollution. This document is a requirement of the Safe Accountable Flexible Efficient Transportation Equity Act - A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) and must be updated every five years.

This Rapid City Area Long Range Transportation Plan consists of two major components. The first component is the development of 25-year traffic forecasts for the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization study area. The forecasted traffic volumes are then used in computer modeling of the transportation network so that future transportation needs can be identified. The second component of the study is the development and evaluation of the planning and prioritization elements within the Long Range Transportation Plan to satisfy the system's future needs. The 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan was formally adopted in September 2005.

OPERATING DOCUMENTATION

Transportation Improvement Program

The Transportation Planning Division annually develops the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which is a staged five-year priority list for transportation projects in the Rapid City Area. The TIP development process involves coordination with the South Dakota Department of Transportation, the participating agencies of the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and the general public. The process is guided by the transportation planning process requirements of the Safe Accountable Flexible Efficient Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU). The purpose of the TIP is to be a fiscal management tool to assist state and local agencies in matching transportation needs with available resources. The TIP development process provides elected officials and the general public the opportunity to identify, evaluate, and select shortrange community transportation improvements. The TIP development process is linked to the Rapid City Area 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan by an emphasis on implementing recommended system improvement projects.

Transportation Planning

nventory Compilations

The Transportation Planning Division provides staff support to the Future Land Use Study through the design and development of future land use inventory compilations. These compilations provide a cohesive match between the future land use data requirements and the traffic forecasting model land use inputs. Additionally staff has designed the process for growth projections using community-wide and neighborhood data.

The Transportation Planning Division in conjunction with the Public Works Department coordinated the traffic counts used for travel demand management, traffic impact analyses and traffic forecasting modeling as well as the geographic information system inputs. There are currently over 300 traffic count locations within the Rapid City planning area. Data provided by the South Dakota Department of Transportation supplements the City's and enhances transportation planning functions.

FUTURE LAND USE PLANNING

Future Land Use Planning

The Rapid City area continues to experience growth in population, commercial/retail development and employment opportunities. Much of the growth is attributable to the rich and varied amenities that the region offers. In order to preserve the high quality of life while at the same time maintaining continued growth, a coordinated emphasis has been placed on planning for the future. The Future Land Use Plan provides the framework for ensuring orderly and efficient growth of the community and encompasses land within the corporate city limits, the three-mile platting jurisdiction and the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization's jurisdiction.

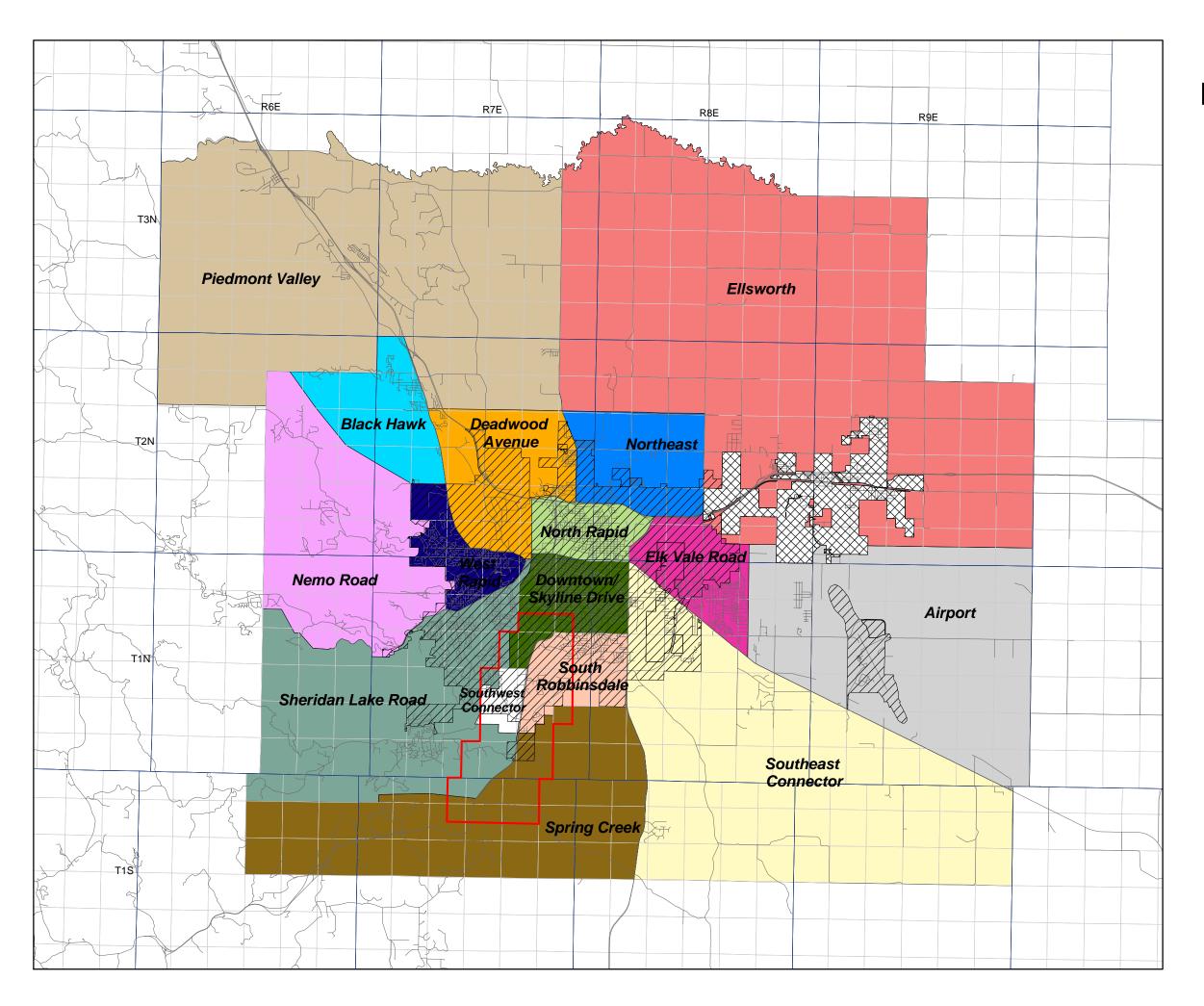
The Future Land Use Plan is an indispensable tool for all sectors of the community. Local government can invest public infrastructure dollars more wisely if the location and magnitude of anticipated growth is identified. Private sector businesses can use the Plan to make more accurate growth projections and better position themselves to meet the needs of the future population. The Plan provides developers and landowners with a clear idea of the location and type of development desired by the community, thus saving time and money in assembling development plans. The Plan also provides citizens with information on how the community and their specific neighborhoods will develop which is a critical factor in decisions about where to live and work.

The Future Land Use Plan is subdivided

into fourteen Neighborhood Study Areas (Figure 5). Land Use Plans were developed in 2005 for two Neighborhood Study Areas: the Airport Neighborhood (March 2005) and the U.S. Highway 16 Neighborhood (May 2005). Combined, these two Neighborhoods account for approximately 33,000 acres of the total study area. Both Plans were developed with significant public input and represent the community's vision for the future.

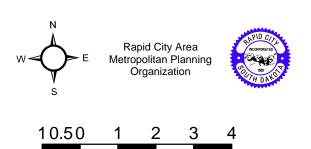
Rapid City Area Future Land Use Plan

GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

The City of Rapid City underwent a major departmental reorganization in 2004 resulting in the development of the Growth Management Department. The purpose and focus of the Growth Management Department shall be to coordinate all community planning and development activities, building permitting and associated inspections, and geographic information systems for the City of Rapid City. The Growth Management Director is the designated liaison to the Rapid City Planning Commission and serves as the Executive Director for the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization. To facilitate the responsibilities of the Growth Management Department the following three divisions were established: Development Services Division, Community Planning Division and GIS Division.

The Development Services Division is responsible for the issuance of building permits, review of development plans, and the review and process development applications, including rezoning requests and Conditional Use Permits, within the City and all subdivision applications within the City and the 3-mile extraterritorial jurisdiction. Staffing for the Development Services Division is provided through teams as follows:

- The Development Review Team provides assistance to the general public by addressing and processing all land use applications including, but not limited to: subdivision plats, Conditional Use Permits, rezoning requests, Planned Development applications, Annexation petitions, Vacation of Utility Easements and/or Right-of-Way requests, Fence Height Exceptions and Variances to the Subdivision Standards. The land use hearing applications are reviewed for compliance with the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations and other applicable provisions of the Rapid City Municipal Code. Additionally, staff provides engineering review of development projects ensuring proposed site plans, subdivisions, and infrastructure plan submittals and construction comply with applicable regulations, City ordinances, design standards and public hearing stipulations. On-site inspections are conducted for private developmental projects involving sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drainage systems, grading, streets, signs, landscaping, signalization, parking lots and more. The Development Review team staff provides the primary support for the Rapid City Statutory Planning Commission.
- The Building Permit Review Team is responsible for the issuance of all building permits within the City of Rapid City. Plans are reviewed for compliance with zoning requirements such as setbacks, use of property, lot coverage, flood plain requirements, parking, temporary uses, etc. Additionally, the staff provides local officials, the general public and others with information regarding state and local regulations along with the application to specific exist-

ing and proposed developments. On-site inspections are conducted to ensure work conforms to the permits, codes and plans and documentation is provided when the construction is complete and code compliance is determined. Staff provides the primary support for the Zoning Board of Adjustments, Sign Code Board of Appeals, Sign Contractor Board, Residential Contractor Board, Plumbing Board, Electrical Board, Mechanical Board, Gas Board and the Americans with Disabilities Act Review committee.

◆ The Air Quality Specialist works to achieve and maintain the PM¹⁰ and PM².⁵ National Ambient Air Quality Standards by controlling fugitive emissions, open burning and wood burning so as to protect the health and welfare of all the people who inhabit the City and the Air Quality Zone; to limit environmental damage to plant and animal life within the County; and to promote commercial and industrial development while limiting environmental degradation; and to educate the residents of the City on air quality issues. This is achieved and maintained through the development and implementation of education, air pollution prevention, abatement and control programs. Air Quality regulations are enforced in the Air Quality Control Zone incorporating areas of both Rapid City and Pennington County and provides primary support for the Rapid City Area Air Quality Board.

The Community Planning Division is responsible for future land use planning, annexation planning and implementation, transportation planning and community development coordination with other governmental entities, including community development block grants. Staffing for the Community Planning Division is as follows:

• Transportation Planning – Transportation Planning and its process plays an important role in the overall development and growth of the City of Rapid City and the surrounding area. This planning has resulted in the development of roads and highways for the safe and efficient movement of vehicular traffic. The Transportation Planning staff provides the primary support for the Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The transportation planning process in the Rapid City Metropolitan Area includes the City of Rapid City, City of Box Elder, Ellsworth Air Force Base, Meade County, Rapid City School District, Black Hills Council of Local Governments, South Dakota Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, and the Rapid Transit System. Staff provides support to the Citizen Advisory Committee, Technical Coordinating Committee, and the Executive Policy Committee. This process results in the development of products and plans that assist in the overall development of the transportation planning process. Staff also provides the primary support to the Bike-Walk-Run Committee.

Growth Management Department

- Future Land Use Planning The adopted Rapid City Comprehensive Plan and amendments is a long range planning policy to guide the physical development of the area in and around Rapid City. The Comprehensive Plan consists of various elements, including an Overview, the Major Street Plan, the Sewer and Water Plan and the Future Land Use Plan. Future Land Use Planning is a collaborative process which develops specific neighborhood plans and involves property owners, local businesses, elected and appointed officials, affected jurisdictions and staff. The Future Land Use Plan is the framework for ensuring orderly and efficient growth of the community. Local government can invest public infrastructure dollars more wisely if the location and type of anticipated growth is identified. Private sector businesses can use the Plan to make more accurate growth projections and better position themselves to meet the needs of the future population. The Plan provides developers and landowners with a clear idea of the location and type of development desired by the community, thus saving time and money in assembling development plans. The Plan enables individual citizens to be more aware of how the community and their specific neighborhoods will develop, assisting them in making more informed decisions about where to live and work. Staff provides the primary support to the Future Land Use Committee, a subcommittee of the Planning Commission.
- Special Projects Planning: On April 2, 2001, the Rapid City Council adopted a Resolution establishing an updated annexation policy and map of Future Annexation Study Areas (Figure 1). Staff uses the adopted Annexation Policy to accomplish the City's annexation goals to ensure the growth and development of the City in an orderly manner. The special project staff provides assistance to a number of committees to help coordinate their work in accordance with local, state and federal guidelines. Additionally, staff develops special planning studies and designs, coordinates, and implements special projects as needed. The Special Projects planner provides the primary support for the Rapid City Historic Preservation Commission, the Rapid City Beautification Committee, the Downtown Historic Sign Committee and the Tax Increment Finance Committee.
- Community Development The City of Rapid City is an entitlement community receiving an annual allocation of Community Development Block Grant funds. The funds are administered through the U.S. Department of Housing and Development and are used to complete projects and programs that benefit low and moderate income residents. All projects or programs requesting Community Development Block Grant funds are reviewed for compliance with eligibility requirements and National Objectives as set forth in the Federal regulations. The City annually solicits applications for funding projects in the community. Funds are allocated based on the City's adopted Consoli-

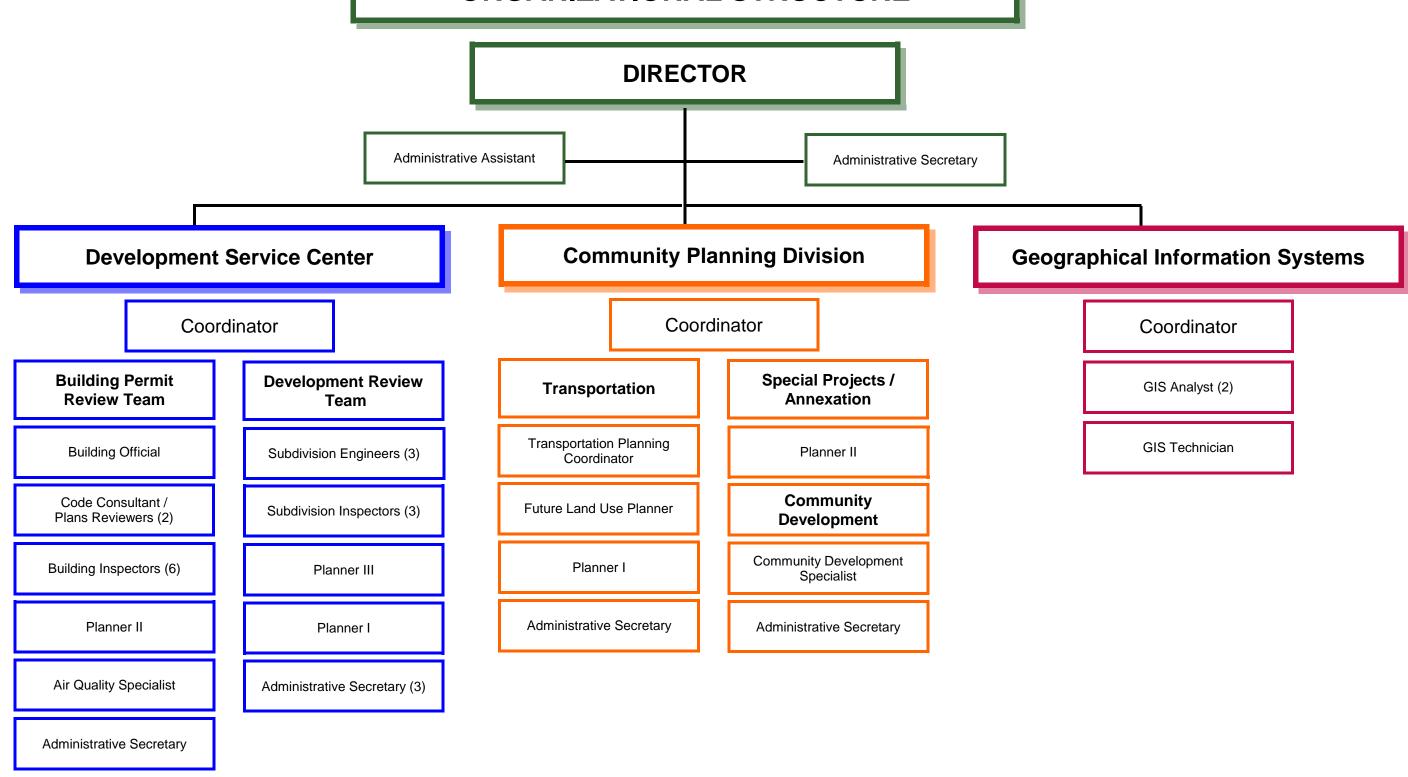
dated Plan that identifies the community's priorities for a five year period. Projects include community services, public infrastructure and housing programs. The City operates the Neighborhood Restoration Program annually which provides financial assistance to homeowners residing within the City limits of Rapid City. Eligibility for the grants and low interest loans for home rehabilitation is based on established income guidelines. The Community Development Specialist provides the primary support for the Community Development Block Grant program. It should be noted that responsibility for the Community Development Division was transferred to the City Attorney's Office in February, 2006.

The Geographic Information System (GIS) Division is directly responsible for collecting geographic information and maintaining the geographic information system. Staff support for the GIS Division is as follows:

• The GIS Division is responsible for collecting geographic information and maintaining the geographic information system. The GIS Division develops numerous maps and related information for use by the City and County. Information available includes interactive maps, prepared maps, digital aerial photographs and topographic contours, and basic information about the land and population of Pennington County. Staff provides the primary support to the GIS Task Force and GIS Technical Committee.
