Currently the Adams Street property is being used as a work release facility and secure detention facility pursuant to the Rapid City Planning Commission's approval of October 27, 2005. The approval was for a one year period for the use as secure detention. Since then the new jail annex has been completed and there are currently no secure detention inmates located at the site. However, the population of the jail is increasing at an ever increasing rate, and it is anticipated that sometime in the future Pennington County may have to use the facility for secure detention for limited periods of time. Since it is impossible to predict when this will occur and it would take time to receive approval from Rapid City to allow secure detention, the County is preemptively requesting approval to facilitate moving inmates to the facility.
