06UR023 Wellspring Signage Plan for the Calvary Lutheran Church Property

Wellspring has no plan or need for any audacious signage. Facility signage will be placed on existing sign structures currently located on the property. These two brick structures will use similar lettering as currently used by Calvary Lutheran Church. Photographic renditions of the planned signage are attached. There are no plans to light any of the signs.

Family Based Programs (only for Dover/Evergreen side)


Lettering will be approximately 6" in height and 3" in width for the sign located near the corner of Evergreen and Dover. With the words: Family Based Programs" in letters approximately 4" in height and 2.5" in width placed directly below Wellspring Inc.

Lettering will be approximately 4" in height and 2.5" in width for both sides of the sign located on the 9<sup>th</sup> Ave side of the church.

The logo itself will be approximately 10" in diameter for the Evergreen/Dover side and approximately 8" in diameter for the 9<sup>th</sup> street side of the church.

The signs will be made of a plastic composite material and attached to existing signage structures with bolts on the rear of the lettering and logo. The actual height and width of letters and the logo may vary slightly based on the need of the sign company to fit the letters properly into the available space.

Administrative office sign on the building near the existing office entrance:



The administrative offices (same location as existing church offices) will be indicated with the addition of the words: Administrative Offices. This sign will be approximately 10" in height and 32" and is a painted aluminum material. The logo is green with black lettering on a white background.
