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SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION

Amendment to the Major Street Plan Comprehensive Plan

On October 15, 2007, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the Adopted Comprehensive Plan to revise the Major Street plan to relocate a collector street and eliminate a collector street on the north 327.2 feet of the N1/2 of the SE1/4 lying west of I90 Right-of-way, excepting therefrom the W1/2 of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4, and less North Boulevard Addition, located in the unplatted (9779); and, the east 670 feet of the south 30 feet of the SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 35, T2N, R7E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, more generally described as being located at 1400 East Philadelphia Street. The Major Street Plan is used to guide the planning of the street network in Rapid City and surrounding area and is necessary for the preservation of street right-of-way for proposed collector and arterial streets. Copies of the Comprehensive Plan, the Major Street Plan and amendments are available for public inspection at the Rapid City Finance Office, 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, South Dakota during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
