Marcia, Ron has asked that I respond to this, so I will attempt to answer your questions.

#1 What type/level of inmates are included in a secure detention facility?

A) Inmates who are classified as medium or minimum security

#2 Does this include inmates other than work release inmates?

A) Yes, some may be pretrial, trustees, or transitional inmates those who are potential candidates for work release.

#3 The description of the facility references "for Pennington County." This raised a question as to whether the the County would house prisoners under contract for the Feds, the State of South Dakota or other counties?

A) Yes, Federal, State, other Counties. Federal & State, work release and transitional programming. Other Counties, work release. We are not doing anything with the State at this time.

#4 Will other classes or other programs operate at the site?

A) It is possible, we are always looking at alternatives to hard lock up as a way to deal with individuals who have committed a crime and need to serve their sentence.
