RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission acknowledge the applicant's withdrawal of the Preliminary Plat application.

GENERAL COMMENTS:

The applicant has submitted a Preliminary Plat to create seven residential lots as Phase Two of the Rockinon Ranch Estates. In addition, the applicant has submitted an Initial and Final Residential Development Plan (#08PD006) that includes 6.183 acres of the Rockinon

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Ranch Estates development, including this property.

On August 9, 2007, the Planning Commission approved a Preliminary Plat (#07PL097) to create seven lots within the Rockinon Ranch Estates. The City Council will consider the Preliminary Plat request at their March 3, 2008 City Council meeting.

The property is located west of Bunker Drive and south of Lennon Lane. Currently, a single family residence is located on the unplatted balance.

STAFF REVIEW:

As noted above, the applicant submitted a Preliminary Plat to create seven lots that will be considered at the March 3, 2008 City Council meeting. This plat includes the same area, and as such, the applicant has subsequently withdrawn this Preliminary Plat request.
