We are asking permission to host a walking event on the bike path, Saturday, May 10, 2008 from 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM. This would be a fundraising event for the Humane Society of the Black Hills. Participants will be asked to make a pledged donation to participate, and donated prizes will be awarded. Our hope is to have 150 participants, 25 volunteers, and 7 vendors.

We would like to have people park in the public parking lot located on the southwest corner of Fifth St. and New York St. We will then meet at the bandshell where we will walk to Roosevelt Park and then return to the bandshell following the same section of the bike path. All animals must be accompanied by their owner, and we intend to obey all leash laws and clean-up ordinances.

The vendors will be located to the south of the bandshell on the concrete pad. Each vendor will be allowed a 10 x 10 ft. space.

This is an annual fund-raising event, scheduled for May 10 at Memorial Park. The Humane Society has rented the bandshell for that day, and by this application requests a Special Event Permit from the Parks Dept.

This is an event where participants raise money for the Humane Society through pledges. Participants receive prizes reflective of the amount of money they raise.

Set-up will be from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m., and the event will begin at 9:00. After registration, participants and their dogs will walk or jog from Memorial Park to Roosevelt Park, and back to Memorial Park using the bike path. People not wishing to complete the entire course can return to Memorial Park as they wish. The Humane Society will provide litter bags for each participant, and on-course water stations for participants and their dogs.

After the participants return to Memorial Park, we will conduct contests and demonstrations on the concrete pad in front of the band shell. The event will conclude by noon, followed by clean-up and breakdown, which will be completed by 1:00 p.m.

Participants will be directed to park their cars in the public parking lot on the Southeast corner of 5th St. and New York St.
