To Whom It May Concern:

The Rapid City Arts Council (RCAC) would like to apply for an annual liquor license to sell beer and wine at the Dahl Arts Center.

In the past we have obtained single date beer and wine liquor licenses for our concerts, receptions, fundraisers and other events. With the expanded Dahl now open, featuring our new large event center, we are renting the space out for other groups to hold their own similar activities, as well as banquets, receptions and other special events where guests typically expect to enjoy beer and wine. The non-profit RCAC generates a modest income from the sales, which helps support our arts programming.

Beyond the obvious cost savings of obtaining an annual license vs. paying for ones individually, holding an annual license would ensure we would be able to allow beer and wine to be served at rental events on a much shorter notice.

Generally, the serving of beer and wine would be during events in the evening and on weekends, ending no later than midnight (typically earlier), although occasional luncheons may request alcohol.
