

Written Statement Describing Proposed Use for 11-6-19 SDCL Review:

The Rapid City Downtown Association has partnered with the Black Hills Overdrive committee to bring the community the Downtown Rapid City Show N' Shine. The purpose of this partnership is to bring participants of both Black Hills Overdrive and the Police Department's Cruiser Night into the downtown area prior to the cruise for an afternoon full of cars, live music and fun. The expected number of Show N' Shine cars is 450-500 vehicles and 3000-5000 visitors to the downtown area. This event will be held on June 13th from 3pm to 7pm. A parade permit request has been submitted and went go to Legal and Finance on 4.1.09 and was passed. The street will likely need to be closed from 1:30pm to 8:00pm. Clean up will be provided by volunteers of the Rapid City Downtown Association, the Black Hills Overdrive Committee and the Counts Car Club.

The event will have temporary structures that will consist of a stage, beer and brat stand, picnic tables and three to six vendors. The stage will be located on 6th Street with the back of the stage facing Alley A. The Knology Stage from the Central States Fair Grounds. The beer and brat stand will be located in the parking stalls on the East side of 6th Street between Main and the Stage (~~South~~^{North} of Alley A). This area will also include a fenced in portion where adults of legal age have been carded and can stay to enjoy their beverage. The vendors will primarily be local businesses that curtail to classic cars. They will be parking their classic vehicles in the parking stalls on the West side of 6th Street adjacent to the Prairie Edge building. The Rapid City Downtown Association is working with Parks and Recreation to add five to ten picnic tables in the beer garden area as well as on the street.

Currently the Rapid City Downtown Association is bidding insurance to cover all summer events. This insurance will cover alcohol and events and will be in place by June 1, 2009.

No permanent structures are proposed and everything will be cleared from the 6th Street right-of-way at the end of the Show N' Shine. Actual locations within the proposed area may be altered based on unforeseen difficulties.
