We are requesting an extension to our major amendment for Eagle Ridge Apartments for 2 years to complete the second and final phase of our Eagle Ridge Apartment project.

In January 2008, we were approved for a 2 year window to complete the final phase of the project. In late May, 2009 Eagle Ridge Apartments was finally awarded a reservation of tax credits from South Dakota Housing Authority, for 2010 tax credits.

Due to the national banking crisis, it may take as long as June, 2010 to physically begin to build the project, as we must complete our construction financing, permanent financing, and a tax credit syndicating partnerships.
