Dear Carroll,

The plans for the above referenced facility were reviewed for compliance with ARSD 67:42:11 Environmental Health Standard for Day Cares. Upon review the plans can be considered approved upon the following conditions.

- The total usable square footage for the area that will be available for Fountain Springs usage is (609 Sq ft.), which qualifies the facility for a maximum client load of **17 clients**. Client Capacity broken down by rooms;

Baby Room	01 clients	Education Room	16 clients
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- The following rooms are approved for use but were not counted towards the maximum client capacity as requested by the facility.

Main Dining Room	13 clients
Activity Room	09 clients
Miller Dining Room A	03 clients
Miller Dining Room B	04 clients
Simpson Dining Room	11 clients
School House	01 clients
Lower Level Break Room	65 clients

- All cribs used must be placed at least three feet apart on all sides not positioned against a wall and must change the crib sheets daily and between use by different children. Stackable cribs may not be used.
- In your application you indicate that you will provide care for children 0 weeks to Kindergarten age. Group Family Day Care facilities must either have a permanently plumbed bath tub or a portable tub for bathing of infants and toddlers. Bathtubs must be emptied immediately after each individual use and must be sanitized with a solution of one ounce household bleach to one quart of water.

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
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- Facilities which care for infants must have a diaper changing table with a top which is easily cleanable and nonabsorbent. The table must be cleaned after each use with a solution of one ounce of household bleach to one quart of water. A hand lavatory is required near the diaper changing area and must be separate from that used in the food preparation area.
- Fountain Springs is a facility that is currently licensed with the South Dakota Department of Health – License and Certification Office. Approval to use parts of this facility for other uses (example: child care) must be approved by that licensing office.
