ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR THE FUTURE ISSUANCE OR TRANSFER OF ON-SALE LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE DOWNTOWN CORE AREA.

WHEREAS the Common Council desires to limit the future issuance or transfer of on-sale liquor licenses within the downtown core area

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Rapid City that it shall be the policy of the City of Rapid City to limit the future issuance or transfer of on-sale liquor licenses within an area bounded on the west by the west side of Seventh Street, on the east by the east side of Fifth Street, on the north by the alley north of Main Street, and on the south by the alley south of St. Joe Street; and

EE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it shall be the policy of the Rapid City Common Council to approve only those new transfers or new applications for on-sale liquor licenses in the above described area to bona fide restaurant facilities who have, and for only so long as they continue to maintain, a Sunday liquor license, provided that the sale of alcoholic beverages constitutes less than thirty per cent (30%) of the gross business transacted by that establishment. The term restaurant as used herein shall mean only a room regularly and in a bona fide manner used and kept open for the serving of meals to guests for compensation which has suitable table accommodations for at least forty (40) guests therein at one and the same time, and a kitchen connected therewith containing conveniences for cooking sufficient to provide meals in a bona fide manner for forty (40) guests at one time and the same time.
