SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION

Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan

On June 21, 2010, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the Comprehensive Plan to change the future land use designation from Medium Density Residential to General Commercial with a Planned Commercial Development on a portion of Tract B of the SE¼ of the SW¼, a portion of the S½ of vacated St. Louis Street right-of-way, and a portion of the east 10 feet of vacated Racine Street right-of-way, Section 31, T2N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, More fully described as follows: Commencing at the southeasterly corner of Tract B of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 31, T2N, R8E, BHM, and the point of beginning, Thence first course curving to the left, along, on a curve with a radius of 354.60 feet, a delta angle of 62°52'17", a length of 389.11 feet, a chord bearing of N56º16'05"W, and chord distance of 369.88 feet; Thence second course: N90°00'00"W, a distance of 142.94 feet; Thence third course: N00°02'43"E, a distance of 128.60 feet; Thence fourth course: S89°30'42"E, a distance of 449.43 feet; Thence fifth course: S00°10'47"W, along the easterly boundary of said Tract B, a distance of 330.17feet to the point of beginning, more generally described as being located north of East Omaha Street between Racine Street and LaCrosse Street; said parcels contain 1.732 acres more or less.
