RE: City Council Appointments to the Future Land Use Committee

The 2010 – 2011 City Council Committee Assignments were recently distributed and identified Gary Brown and Sam Kooiker as the Council representatives to the Future Land Use Committee, with Jordan Mason as an alternate. As such, it would be appropriate for the Planning Commission to appoint Gary Brown and Sam Kooiker as the Council representatives and Jordan Mason as an alternate to the Future Land Use Committee.

The Planning Commission established the Future Land Use Committee in 1997 as a working group to provide recommendations to the Planning Commission on development of the Future Land Use Plan element of the adopted Comprehensive Plan.

The Committee is comprised of two City Council members, two Planning Commission members, a school district representative and one member to represent the community at-large. Last September, the Planning Commission added two additional Planning Commissioners (Erik Braun and Linda Marchand).
