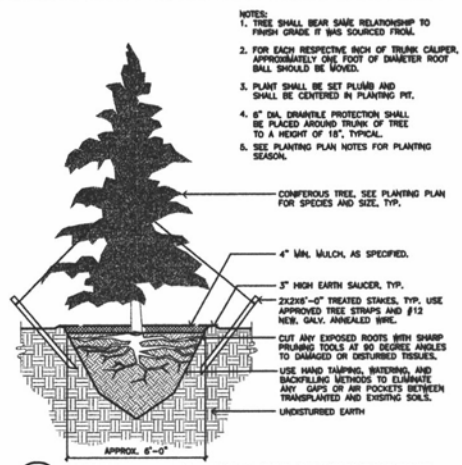
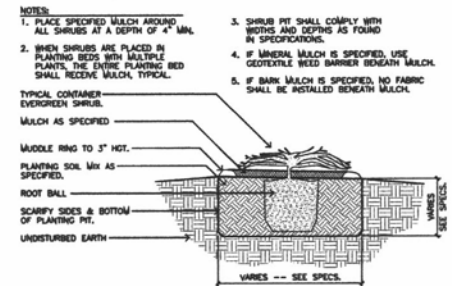


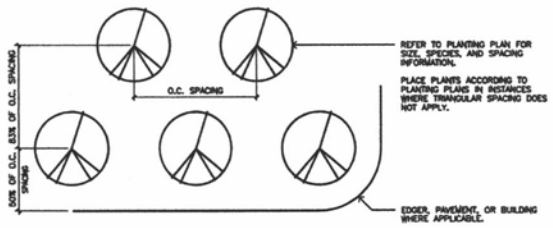
1 SECTION: TYPICAL B&B DECIDUOUS TREE  
19a NO SCALE



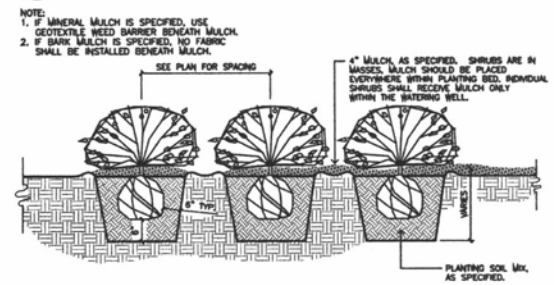
2 SECTION: 12' TRANSPLANTED CONIFEROUS TREE  
19a NOT TO SCALE



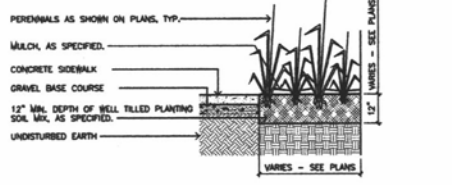
3 SECTION: CONTAINER CONIFEROUS SHRUB  
19a NO SCALE



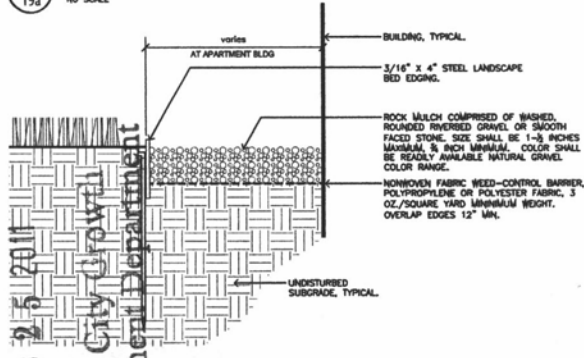
4 PLAN: TYPICAL TRIANGULAR SPACING PLANTING LAYOUT

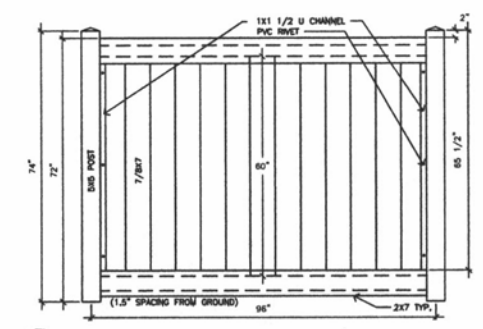
5 SECTION: TYPICAL SHRUB PLANTING BED

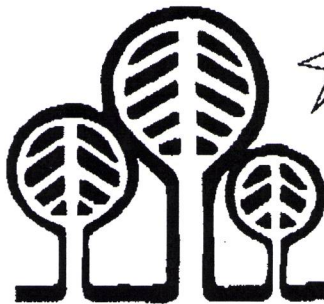
