## **SUMMARY OF ADOPTION ACTION**

### Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan

On November 7, 2011, the Rapid City Council approved an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendment will revise the Comprehensive Plan to change the land use designation from General Commercial to Light Industrial for Lot 1A of Starlite Subdivision located in Section 28, T2N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, more generally described as being located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Dyess Avenue and Eglin Street, and containing approximately 5.83 acres, more or less.
