From The attached March & April parking counts, we suggest that the Ordinance stipulated Parking Space need is inappropriate and oversized for this campus' historically proven need. Even using a conservative 35% surplus from the Block 99 projection of 461 spaces would leave us with a realistic need of 171 spaces on Block 99. We have documented an average surplus of 227 Spaces existing. We are supplying 262 additional spaces between the parking structure and the surface parking @ Block 99.

We feel that we have exceeded the parking demand required for this use and have demonstrated that historic usage justifies the spaces we propose to provide.
