- RE: Amendment #12-007 to the 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program

Attached for your review and approval is Amendment #12-007 to the 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program. This amendment will allow Rapid Transit System to utilize \$1.68 million in Federal Transit Administration grant funds awarded to the City of Rapid City as part of the Federal Transit Administration's State of Good Repair grant program. The funds will be used to replace transit buses that have reached their maximum useful life. This Amendment will move vehicle purchases from 2013 into 2012.

Rapid City was one of 300 public transportation projects selected in a very competitive process. The Federal Transportation Administration reviewed 839 project applications representing over \$4.9 billion in funding requests. The federal transit grant funds provide 80% of the cost to procure the vehicles. The grant application was submitted by the State of South Dakota Department of Transportation, with input from Rapid Transit staff.
